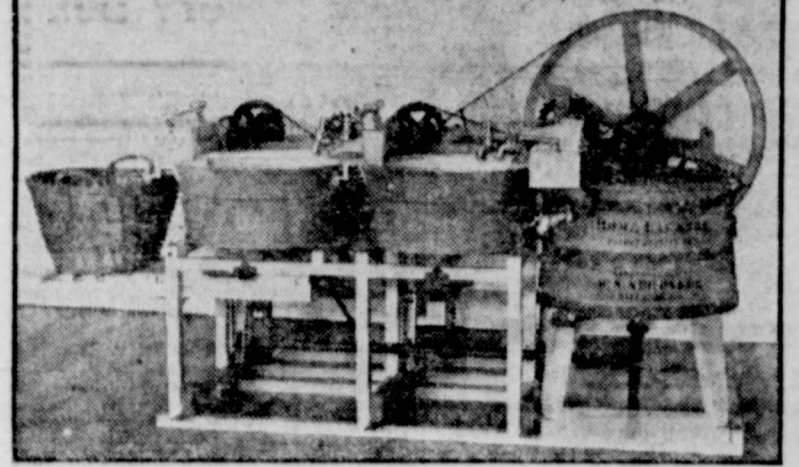

WOULD BAR KANSAS FEED

Missouri Railroad Commissioner Asks Hadley to Establish Quarantine.

Monett, Mo., Sept. 21.—Frank A. Wightman, railroad and warehouse commissioner, after a conference with Dr. M. R. Trumbower of this city, who from 1902 to 1908 was a special government veterinarian at Washington, wired Governor Hadley, stating Dr. Trumbower's views as to the epidemic among horses in Kansas and Nebraska, and advising a quarantine against feed stuff and grains from the infected sections.
