PLAN TO MAKE ROME SEAPORT. The latest project to make Rome a seaport is to lay out a port 35 feet deep near Castel Fusaro, formed by running two jetties out into the sea for some distance, as at the port of Ymuiden, Holland. From the port will lead a ship canal 15 miles long and 200 feet wide and 27 feet deep. At Rome shipping accommodations will be laid out in the river below the city, and this will be connected with the navigable part of the Tiber by a system of locks. It will cost about \$15,000,000 to carry out the project.
