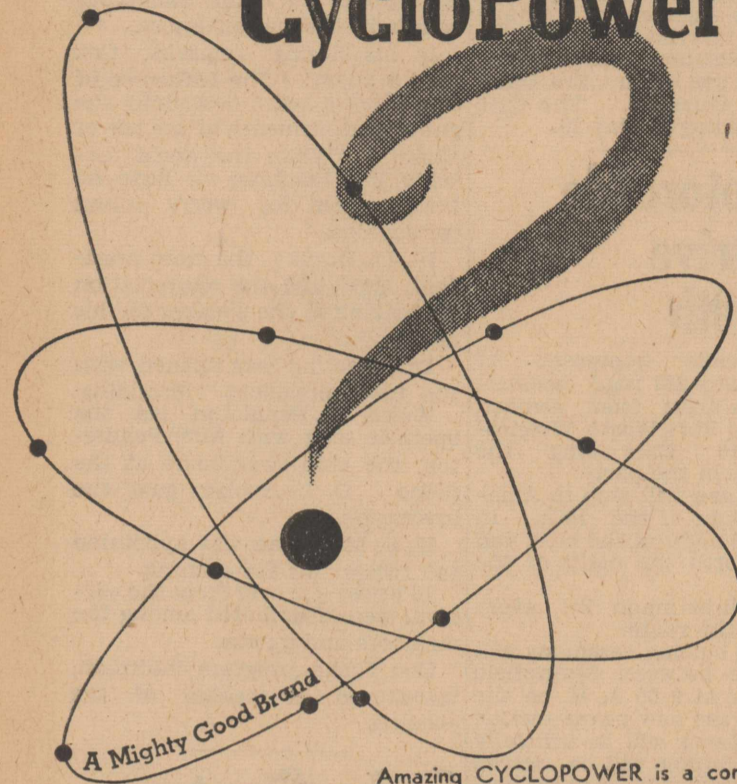

Many ministers have recognized this for what it was, and others have latched onto the idea, and preach it Sunday after Sunday.

This is not to be considered as criticism of the churches, at all, but criticism of some individual ministers who have become disciples of some of the literature sent out to local ministers by a few high ranking individuals in a few church organizations. The fact that these high ranking individuals have also been found listed among the leaders and directors of numerous other organizations that have been proven to be definitely left-wing organizations is ample proof of their intentions.

The brand of Socialistic propaganda preached by these individuals is not the exact brand outlined by Marx, but rather it is the Fabian variety that has taken hold in England. The only basic difference is that the Marxian variety is atheistic and more stress is put on revolution, violence and general bloodshed. The ideals of both varieties advocate the elimination of profit, government control or ownership of all basic industries, and government control of prices and wages. The individual, as such, ceases to exist, and everything must be for the good of the "order." The fact that the churches of England played a very important part in the recent establishment of such a system there, is convincing evidence that it is not unreasonable to assume the same sort of tactics are being used here. Many of them are the same churches.

My only bone of contention with the churches is that the situation should be recognized and cast out, rather than permit it to grow through loyalty of one minister to another. As they used to tell me when I was a child, "There's nothing wrong in getting the itch, the harm is in keeping it." The church is too high and noble an institution to harbor such stuff in the name of Christianity. Though my church attendance is not as regular as could be, I have never heard any mention or admission of these facts by any minister in the pulpit, but I have heard the propaganda preached. Why do not ministers present these things to their congregations so that they may know what is going on in their church, and let the members clean up the organization. The ministers receive the publications, both of their church and the inter-church organizations, which few of their congregation ever see. You and I as members

of our various churches have a right to know if our money and name are being used in the support of Communistic ideals.

I will only make mention of two inter-church organizations whose policies and leadership have been definitely left-wing. These are the "World Council of Churches" and "The Federal Council of Churches". A large number of other church organizations have either been proven to be pink-tinged or are under suspicion. I do not know if any church in our town is a member of either of these two organizations, but if so should protest their policies in a loud voice or get out. I do not believe that the majority of the people of any church in the Panhandle of Texas favor either Socialism or Communism, so why should they permit their money and the good name of their church to be used by a Communist-front organization.

Remote as we are from the hotbeds of Communism in the industrial areas of the North and East, we have seen nothing of the soap orators and Communist demonstrations we generally associate with the word, and consequently think that we are far removed from any trace of Communism, but we may be only as far as our nearest school or church. It makes little difference by which route Communism is achieved: by revolution, invasion, ballot, teaching, or preaching, the result will be the same.

**Enameling New Woodwork**  
If new interior woodwork is to be enameled, the first step is to apply a liquid filler. After that should come one or two coats of enamel undercoater, tinted to approximate the finishing color desired. These should be followed by one or two coats of gloss or semi-gloss enamel. 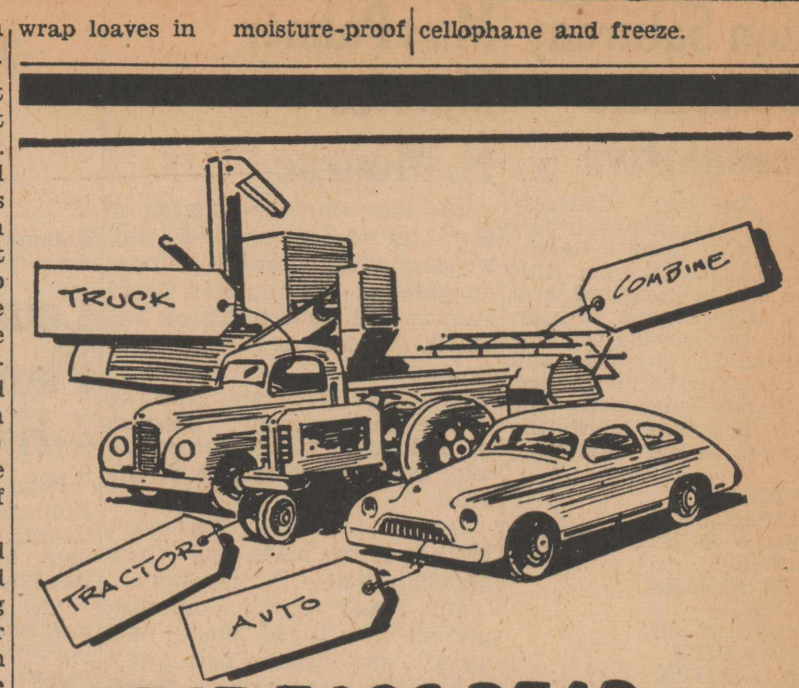

Rain by the Yard

Looking at long-time averages, Hawaii probably can claim about the wettest spot on the globe's dry land. On the seaward slope of its Mt. Waialeale, 42 feet of rainfall is recorded in an average year. But for vast spreading Hawaiian acres, where sugar cane and pineapple grow, irrigation is essential to the crops. The vapor-laden monsoon off the Bay of Bengal drowns forests of the mountains of Burma and Assam in rain that totals 30 feet a year at some points. Most of it falls in two summer months. In contrast, desert reaches on the several continents vie for "driest" honors with points where annual rainfall ranges from virtual zero to one inch.

### This Is National H. D. Week

A million and a half women are observing National Home Demonstration Week from April 30 to May 6th. There are 56,151 Home Demonstration Clubs organized to carry on the educational programs in homes and communities.

"Today's Home Builds Tomorrow's World," has been selected as the theme for the observance. Home Demonstration work started principally to help farm women simplify their household tasks; has expanded until today it embraces all phases of homemaking in a broader sense in both rural and urban areas. It seeks, for example, to stimulate gracious living through better housing, health, recreation, and art. Each year it brings new methods to the science of homemaking based on facts from the experiment stations.

During this week radio programs will feature stories of Home Demonstration Work. Listen to the Texas Farm and Home Program each weekday on the Texas Quality Network at 6:00 A. M. and the Farm Revue at 6:30 A. M. on Saturday.

**Swine Influenza Spread**

Swine influenza spreads rapidly once it strikes a herd. Within two or three days after the first pig gets sick, the entire herd may be down with the disease. Affected pigs cough, go off feed, and appear exhausted. They have fever, breathing is hard and jerky, and sometimes there is a watery discharge from the eyes. Unless complications set in, the animals usually start to recover about five or six days after the first signs of illness. Deaths are few, but an attack always lowers vitality and causes loss of weight. When an animal is stricken during pregnancy, loss of part of her litter is almost certain.

**Search Is Abandoned**

DOGUBAYAZIDI, TURKEY.—The hunt for Noah's Ark by an American expedition has been abandoned. The search was called off after 12 days of fruitless search on Mount Ararat.

But, Dr. Aaron J. Smith, retired missionary from Greensboro, N.C., who led the search, thinks the wooden ark which the Bible says rode out the great flood, is still hidden somewhere on the rocky, three-mile-high mountain.

"We have cleared the way for future expeditions," Dr. Smith declared. "We expect other missions to complete the job we have begun."

Smith headed a group of five Americans who were escorted by Turkish soldiers over crags and through drifts of volcanic ash. The others were Walter Wood, Sea Cliff (N.Y.) development engineer; Wendell Ogg, Knoxville (Tenn.) physicist; E. J. Newton, Colfax (N. C.) interior decorator, and this correspondent.

Every part of Mount Ararat was searched, including the five mile plateau extending between the main mountain and small Ararat peak.

Household Hints

Sweet Potato Color As soon as they're peeled, raw sweet potatoes have a strong tendency to turn color; this can be prevented by keeping them in ice-cold water until ready for cooking.

No Soggy Salad To prevent a salad from getting soggy, put a saucer upside down first in the bottom of the bowl, then put the salad on top of it.

Soda for Plates Gold borders on plates usually can be cleaned by scrubbing with a dry toothbrush dipped in bicarbonate of soda.

Use For Margarine To color margarine for table use, put the electric mixer to work. Then, without cleaning the stray margarine off the mixing paddles, use the mixer for whipping the mashed potatoes for the evening meal. Thus, the stray margarine ends up in the potatoes.

Cleaning Frying Pan If a frying pan is exceptionally greasy and must be washed, fill it with soap, hot water and ammonia and let it soak awhile first.

Counteracting Salt If you get too much salt in the soup or gravy, counteract it by adding a teaspoonful of sugar and one of vinegar and cooking it a while longer.

Grind Bread Crumbs When bread crumbs are to be used for frying, put stale slices of bread through the meat grinder and mix the crumbs with equal parts of flour.

Radish Roses For making roses out of radishes and other fancy garnishes, it is much handier if a penknife is used instead of a paring knife.

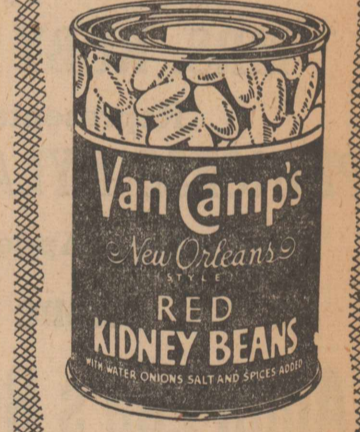
