April Designated Cancer Month

April is designated as the month in which the American public is urged to become aware of cancer, its causes, and some of the ways of preventing it. Five causes of cancer as outlined by scientific research are: over-exposure to sunlight; action of

certain chemicals; constant irritation of warts, moles or sore places; prolonged exposure to heat.

People who work in the sun are particularly susceptible to skin cancer on hands, face, and neck. Statistics show that in Texas, which gets 60 to 80 percent to total possible sunlight, 140 out of every possible one hundred thousand develop skin cancers; in Michigan, which gets

half as much sunlight, the rate is 24 per hundred thousand. 95 percent of all cases of skin cancer are curable if precaution is taken early enough. Periodical physical check-ups

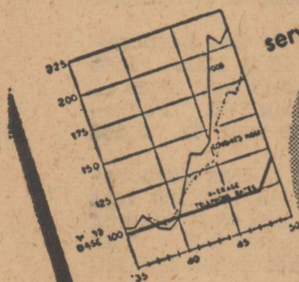

Grand Jury Files Four Indictments

Four indictments were filed by the grand jury while in session Monday.

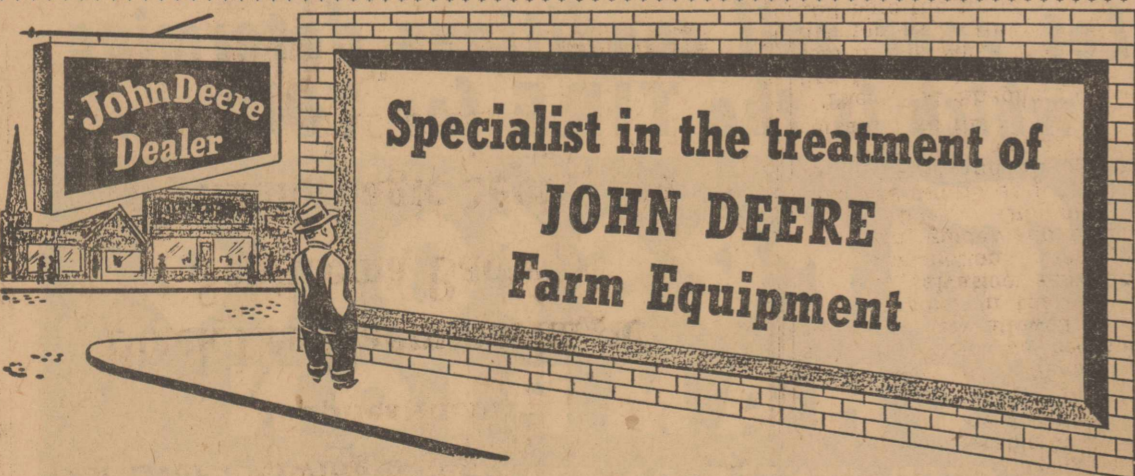
