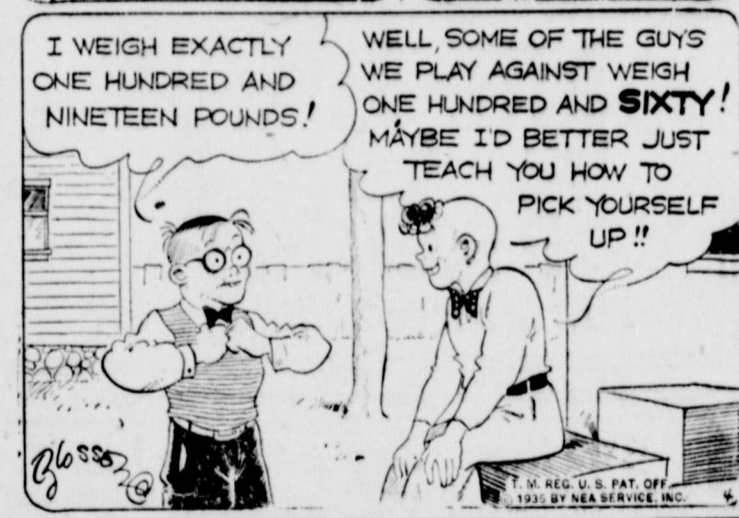
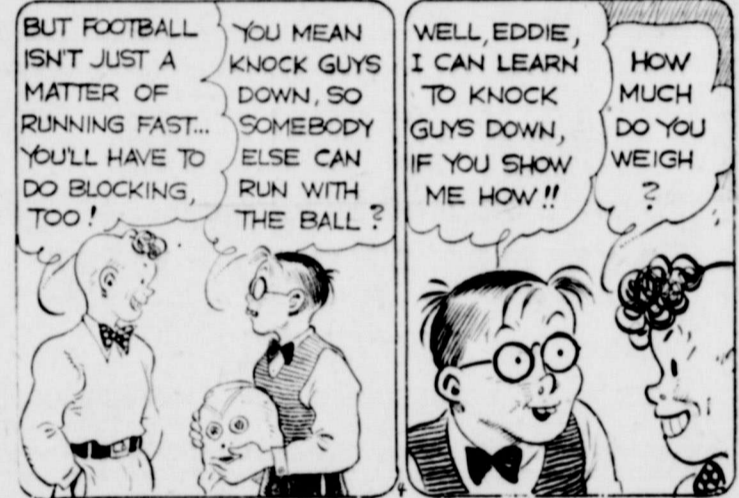

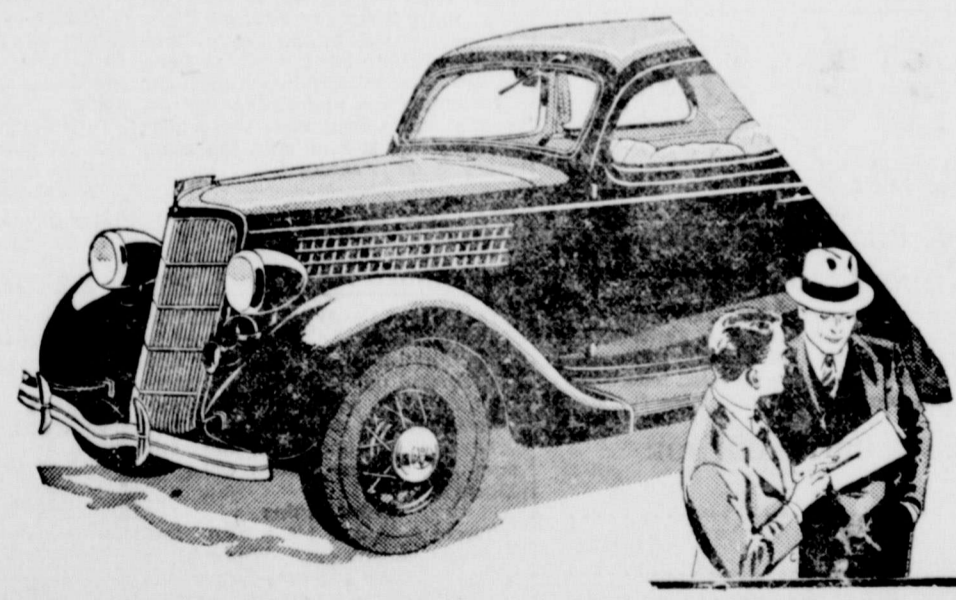

LIST CLASSES OF LIVESTOCK FOR EXHIBIT

Plans are going forward for making the Eastland County Livestock show here Oct. 25 and 26 the best ever staged in the county, according to J. M. Bird, agriculture expert of the Cisco Chamber of Commerce, Thursday.

As the date for the show nears committees named by the Chamber of Commerce will continue to work out plans for entertainment and other features.

Bird said Thursday that classes in the various types of stock had been arranged. He announced the list as follows:

Beef Cattle
Bull 18 months and over, bull under 18 months, bull -ix to 12 months, bull under six months, cow under two years, cow over 2 years, heifer under 12 months, heifer under six months, junior steer under 900 pound, senior steer over 900 pounds, champion steer, champion bull, champion cow.

Dairy Cattle
Bull 18 months and over, bull under 18 months, bull under 6 months, cow over four year, cow two to four years, heifer under 12 months, heifer under two years, champion bull, champion female, young herd (one male and three females).

Sheep
Ram two years and over, ram one year and under two, ram lamb under one year, ewe two years and over, ewe one year and under two, ewe lamb under one year, pen (three fat wether lambs) champion ram champion ewe.

Goats
Buck two years and over, buck one year and under two, buck kid under one year, doe two years and over, doe one year and under two, doe kid under one year, champion buck, champion doe.

Hogs
Boar one year and under two, boar pig under one year, sow two years and over, sow one year and under two, sow pig under one year, litter of pigs and sow, champion sow, champion boar, fat barrow 175 to 250 pounds, fat barrow 250 pounds.

Draft Horses
Stallion four years and over, stallion under four years, mare four years and over, mare under four years, champion stallion, champion mare, draft mare under 18 months.

Mules
Mule three years and over, mule under three years, champion mule, pair of mules three years and over, pair of mules under three years, best pair of mules any age.

Saddle Horses
Mare any age, gelding any age.

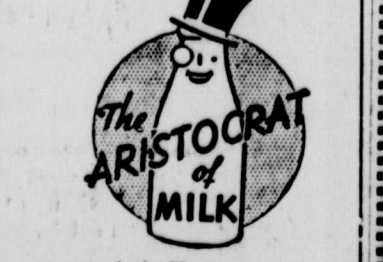

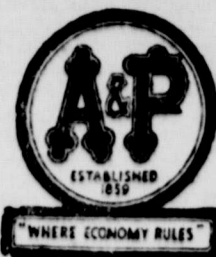

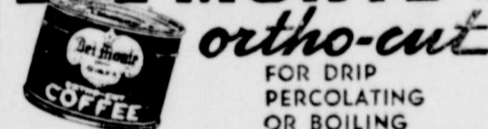
