Nancy Brannon and Judge Harris Worcester of the State Democratic Executive Committee conducted the meeting. Plans and strategies for

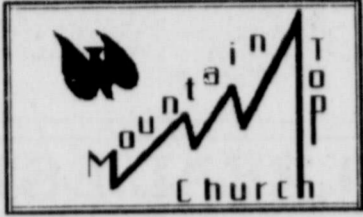
the State Convention in Fort Worth, June 8, were made.

Non-surgical treatment for prostate problems is under investigation in London. In hyperthermic treatment, a microwave instrument heats the gland for an hour at a time, monitored and controlled by computer.

Laser beam that travels in a flexible fiber is being tested for dental use at Marquette University. The NdYAG laser is expected to be more useful than the carbon dioxide laser to vaporize decay and infected tissue in various procedures.

Use of the drug misoprostol is recommended to avoid the gastric upset and ulceration that may accompany the frequent use of nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory drugs, according to a report in the journal Geriatrics. The report says misoprostol does not interfere with the pain-killing effect of the NSAID.

## Fishing Outdoors

### FISHING OUTDOORS

Wide spread spring rains are producing excellent habitat conditions for wildlife, especially in the brush country of South Texas which has been hit by more than three years of dry conditions.

Biologists of the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department believe 1990 will be a bumper production year for most wildlife especially ground-nesting birds such as turkey and quail.

Recent heavy rains caused unwelcome flooding to many areas of North and East Texas, but in South Texas the above farmers, ranchers and wildlife biologists beaming. At the Chaparral Wildlife Management area in Dimmit and La Salle Counties, biologist Bill Brummel said the habitat is in better shape than it has been in years. "We had three and a half inches of rain during April and over 10 inches since Jan 1. That's more than five inches ahead of the average rainfall for this time of year.

Brummel said nesting conditions are excellent for bobwhite quail whose populations hit record lows in 1989.

"We may not have extremely high quail populations this year because the number of holdover birds from last year was low but the birds that are out there should have excellent nesting success," said Brummel.

Conditions also appear optimum for white-tailed deer fawn production and survival, after several years of low fawn crops.

It appears the Eastland Lake Dam has held once again after some heavy rains the past month. Condemned by the state and many locals this dam was a big factor in slowing water enough to allow Lake Leon to get rid of some excess. And probably helped avoid some serious flooding in our area.

This weekend the Big Bass event on Lake Hubbard Creek will once again be host to anglers from across the nation. Unofficial word out of Breckenridge is that this will be the last year this event will be held at Wimberly's Wharf and possibly at Hubbard all together. Unless tournament officials can better justify the continued decline of less

money being returned to contestants. A major geological move might be needed.

Results from the Eastland County Bass Club may tournament held at Lake Ballinger were not reported in time for this piece, but will be available at the June 7 meeting. For more information you may call Tom Maynard at 629-3550.

At last report the Wednesday evening jackpots were still starting at 6:00 p.m. with headquarters at Chock-O-Block. Again if you wish more information you may contact Tom Maynard.

Leon's black bass are back in full swing with some real nice strings of fish being taken in shallow water on worms and spinners. Shad imitation colors seem to be working best in the mid lake areas.

Till next cast remember "It's scatch and 'Live' release."

## Corps Of Engineers To Repair Flood Control Projects

As a result of recent floods, the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers, Fort Worth District, is accepting requests for assistance to rebuild flood control projects damaged by high waters.

Non-federal flood control projects, such as levees, are built to prevent damage to low-lying areas. However, severe flooding in certain areas breached or over-topped levee systems. The Corps may provide assistance on a cost-share basis to restore these

structures to normal operations provided the work is economically justified and not prohibited by law.

Assistance is available primarily in the counties declared federal disaster areas. (See map) However, request for assistance may be expanded to other locations as flood waters flow south to the Gulf.

## Railroad Commission Assesses \$37,000 In Penalties

The Railroad Commission assessed a total of \$37,000 in penalties this week to seven oil and gas operators for problems under Commission well plugging and pollution rules. Collingsworth Oil Company of Wellington was penalized a total of \$10,000 for five inactive and unplugged wells: one on the Jackson "A" lease in Gray County; the other four on the Trostle lease in Wheeler County; Putnam Oil Operator Account of Throckmorton was assessed \$3,000 for one well on the Putnam lease in Throckmorton County; Riverside Oil & Gas Co., Inc. of San Antonio was ordered to pay \$3,000 for one well on the W. O. Winsaur lease in Bee County; Uselton Oil Company of Wichita Falls was penalized \$8,000 for four wells on the McCullough & Howard lease in Wichita County; and, A. W. S. Petroleum Co. of San Angelo was assessed \$3,000 for one well on the Wright lease in Eastland County.

In addition, Fred B. Shelton III, Inc. of Dallas was ordered to pay \$5,000 for problems with a leaking well and having unauthorized oil field pits on the E. H. Jones Estate "A" lease in Gaines County; and, Bob's Oil & Gas Operating Company of Luling was penalized \$5,000 for oil spills and unauthorized discharge into earthen pits on the V. Lackey lease in Caldwell County.

To date in 1990, the Commission has levied more than \$406,000 in pollution and well plugging penalties. Last year, the Commission assessed a total of \$1,125,000 in such penalties.

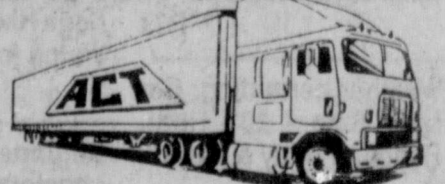

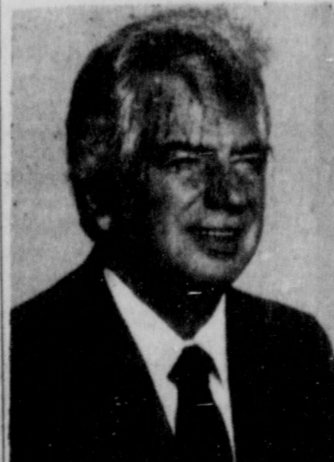

## Dixie Yeats Joins Abilene Naval Reserve Center

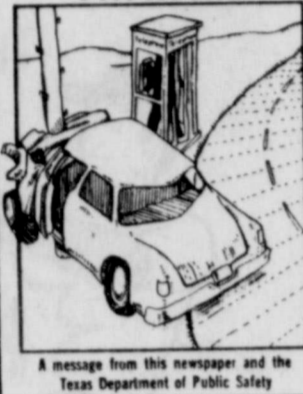
The Abilene Naval Reserve Center, Abilene, has announced the recent enlistment of HM2 Dixie (Ann) Yeats to the Naval Reserves.

#### Correct Use of Child Safety Seats



The U.S. Department of Transportation points out to parents there is only one safe way for children to ride in cars—correctly buckled in a child safety seat. Check your instruction manual to learn if the seat should be installed facing the rear or forward. Improper use of these life-saving devices reduces their effectiveness so always use and install seats according to manufacturer instructions.

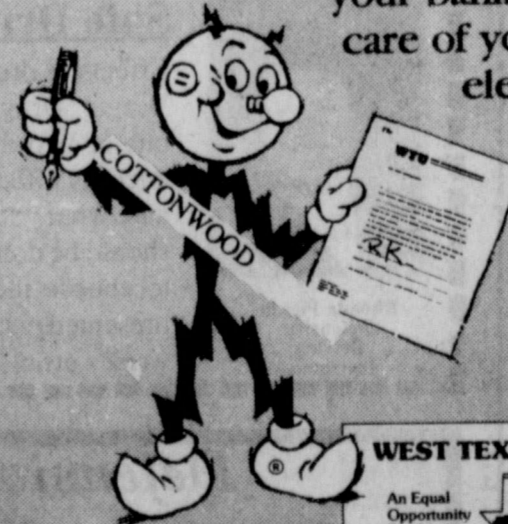
