Expenses for education of the handicapped far outweigh available federal funding, but state and local money help provide adequate financial support in the Lubbock public school system, the district's special education director says.

Green said, "While I suppose we could always use more money if we could spend all we had, we have an adequate amount of money to meet most of the needs of the handicapped students in this district."
He said that "total expenditures are quite a bit more than we get from the federal government through P.L. 94-142," but that the state provides the bulk of the funding.

WASHINGTON (AP) — Farmers wanting higher crop prices and continued incentives for gasoline are getting a good reception in Congress with their toned-down lobbying this year, American Agriculture Movement Chairman Marvin Meek says.

City Council Candidate Godowic Withdraws

The race for Place 4 on the Lubbock City Council lost one candidate Tuesday. Texas Tech University freshman John Gregory "Ziggy" Godowic notified City Secretary Evelyn Gaffa that he will not run for the council seat and requested that his name be removed from the ballot.

Godowic is one of two 18-year-olds who had announced plans to run for council posts. Coronado High School senior Bill Roddy announced Feb. 7 his plans to run for mayor but he has not submitted the official filing papers in that race.

AUSTIN — Two persons convicted of crimes in the Lubbock area have been paroled by Gov. Bill Clements on recommendation of the Texas Board of Pardons and Paroles.

Manuel Oliviero, convicted of burglary of a habitation in Hockley County in 1977, had his parole revoked for unsatisfactory adjustment. Oliviero had been on parole since May 18, 1979.

## Biography Depicts Hadassah Founder

NEW YORK (Special) — At the unlikely age of 59, Henrietta Szold, the founder of Hadassah, embarked on the greatest adventure of her life, an adventure "so big that in spite of my age, I feel young and strong. It is very, very wonderful, this experience in these last days of my life." The year was 1921, and Henrietta Szold had been summoned to Jerusalem.

Recently, Harper & Row published the first full-scale biography of this fascinating and crusty woman: "SUMMONED TO JERUSALEM: The Life of Henrietta Szold" by Joan Dash. Drawn from archives and letters, as well as from reminiscences of the fast disappearing generation of family members,

colleagues, friends and antagonists who knew Miss Szold firsthand, the book is more than an intimate portrait of the remarkable and complicated woman who abruptly switched careers in midlife. "Summoned To Jerusalem" also provides a history of Hadassah, the woman's arm of the American Zionist movement, founded by Miss Szold in 1912, and today the largest Zionist organization in the world. The book tells us much about the history of Zionism — its various networks and factions in Europe, America and Palestine; its principal proponents such as Theodor Herzl, Chaim Weizmann and Louis Brandeis; and its interaction with big power politics. And finally, we are witness to the evolution of modern Palestine from its early Jewish

settlers through the founding of the State of Israel.

Born in Baltimore in 1860, Henrietta Szold was the eldest of six daughters (two died in infancy) and her rabbi father's aide and secretary. Joan Dash writes that: "From infancy on she spoke German as readily as English, but she learned Hebrew during long hours in her father's study, the only one of his children to do so. Whatever was precious to him he transmitted to Henrietta: Jewish literature and history, Jewish jokes; the weakness of the Jews as well as their grandeur always held for her the glamor of her father's presence."

Through the 1920s Henrietta Szold helped establish the health care, sanitation, child care, education and social service systems that serve Israel today. Through her efforts, too, Hadassah increasingly tied American Jewish women together, "uniting rich and poor, German and Russian, college-trained social worker and the peddler's wife." Ultimately Hadassah emerged as the most powerful voice in American Zionism.

In the 1930s a new mission emerged — the rescue of thousands of Jewish children from Nazi Europe and their rehabilitation in Palestine. As director of Youth Aliyah (Immigration) Miss Szold, then in her seventies, "lived at a furious pace; at a run, gasping, hoping against hope that if I sleep less I'll catch up to myself." She never did... One day in Jerusalem a high wind picked her off her feet, tore away her umbrella, threw her to the ground and tumbled her over and over. She scrambled back up, rescued her possessions and ran on again. There was no time to rest."

Through her organizational skills and determination, some 10,000 children were saved from extinction.

In 1945 the indomitable Henrietta Szold wearied at last. She is buried on the Mount of Olives in Israel.

Both Wests ducked and dummy's king took the trick. A second trump put East in with the ace in order to lead the jack of diamonds to South's queen and West's ace.

At table one, West led back a diamond. South ruffed, cashed all the clubs, led his jack of hearts and let it ride. East took the queen and South claimed the rest of the tricks, since East had been thoroughly end played.

At the other table, West took time to count out South's hand. West saw that two tricks in the red suits would be necessary if he wanted to set declarer. If East held the king of hearts and a winning club, any lead back would work; if East held both king and queen of hearts, an immediate heart lead was necessary to stop the potential end play.

So West led a heart and declarer was walking around dead.

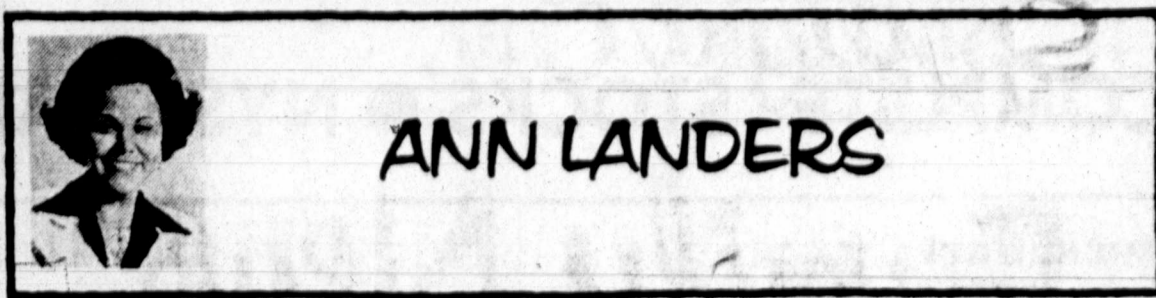

## Widow Continues Column

NEW YORK (WNS) — Mrs. Esther Margolius will continue the widely syndicated consumer feature column that her husband, Sidney Margolius, had been doing until his death recently. Mr. Margolius died of a heart attack. He was 67 years old.

Sidney Goldberg, executive editor of Women's News Service, announced Feb. 1 that Mrs. Margolius will continue the features.

The decision to turn over the column to Mrs. Margolius was an easy one, Goldberg said, because the two had closely collaborated for years. The New York Times, in its obituary, gave one example of this collaboration between husband and wife. When Margolius was working on his "The Great American Food Hoax," published in 1971, the NYTimes said, "he and his wife spent weeks in their kitchen dissecting packaged foods with tweezers to see, for example, whether the chicken dinner inside the package was as full of peas as the one pictured on the cover. One brand, it turned out, contained only one pea."

Frances Cerra, who wrote the NYTimes piece, pointed out that "a generation of young consumer journalists found (Margolius) warm and generous with his advice on methods and materials, asking only that they give him credit for the original research they borrowed. He did much of the research with his wife, Esther."

Margolius spent the last 40 years as a consumer journalist and, in fact, was a pioneer in the field, having supervised a staff of more than a dozen consumer reporters at New York's PM newspaper in the 1940s — "long before (consumer journalism) was fashionable," as the NYTimes put it.

"He was never inaccurate or unfair," said White House consumer affairs adviser Esther Peterson, "and he earned the respect of both industry and consumers."

Margolius' first book, (he did 20 in all) was a runaway best-seller, "The Consum-

ers Guide to Better Buying" went through five editions and sold a million copies.

The consumer writer also served in numerous local and national government advisory posts, including the President's Consumer Advisory Council during the Johnson administration. He served, too, on various organization boards, including that of Consumers Union.

Besides his wife Esther, Margolius is survived by a son, Richard.

Margolius' "For the Consumer" feature column has been syndicated by Women's News Service for the past 15 years.

NEW YORK (AP) — Stock prices tumbled on Tuesday as the chairman of the Federal Reserve Board warned that inflation will not easily be checked and as interest rates rose sharply.

The Dow Jones average of 30 industrial stocks fell 8.66 to 876.07, for its third straight losing session. Losing stocks outnumbered gainers by a margin of more than 3-1 on the New York Stock Exchange.

Paul A. Volcker, the Fed chairman, told a congressional hearing inflation "could well accelerate in the first quarter of 1980, in part because of higher oil prices."

He promised to make "every reasonable effort" to hold down growth in the money supply, leading some Wall Street analysts to speculate the Federal Reserve will further tighten credit.

Reacting to the Federal Reserve's latest move, an increase in the discount rate charged on loans to commercial banks, major banks led by Chase Manhattan Bank raised their prime lending rates from 15 1/4 percent to 15 3/4 percent.

# Communion Rituals Of Breaking Bread, Drinking Wine Symbolize Beginning

(First of Eight Parts)

And he took bread, and gave thanks, and broke it, and gave unto them, saying, "This is my body which is given for you; this do in remembrance of me." Like wise also the cup, after supper, saying, "This cup is the new testament in my blood, which is shed for you."  
— Luke 22: 19, 20.

There is more there than the plain tale of a sad parting with a bit of bread and a cup of wine, said the late Lutheran minister Paul Scherer.

There was more to it on that fateful Thursday night of Holy Week in the upper room. And there is more to it than that today, 49 generations after.

There was the sanctity of Middle Eastern custom about this occasion between Jesus and his 12 disciples.

Among the Syrians, whenever a man was about to leave his friends and go on a long journey, there was a kind of ritual involved.

He gathered his friends around for one last pledge of his love. He gave them food and told them to eat it. For all the distances and years between, it would be as his body to theirs — with all that meant in the way of strength and companionship and love.

And with his own hand he gave them wine to drink. It would be as the blood of his life to their life. Never would he be anywhere away from them — not for a moment beyond the reach of any man's heart.

to fathom the meaning of it all.

And as time passed something strange happened. They began to find in those words not a figure of speech but the very bestowal of that life which they themselves had handled and touched as he

near to the Lord's table with faith and have taken this holy sacrament to their comfort.

They have experienced pardon and deliverance from their sins, have been confirmed and strengthened in goodness, filled with his grace and heavenly benediction and made one body with him.

This does not appear to have been the

experience of everybody — or even the experience of anybody all of the time. But so often has the testimony been made that the church's theologians have speculated — some have even laid it down as a fact — that Christ himself is really present in the sacrament.

Those with a more practical and less theological turn of mind may leave the discussion at this point — but not before

making their witness that, however the theologians may want to explain it, "something happens" when a man or a woman humbly partakes of this spiritual food.

Thus is the holy communion more than a symbol. A symbol depicts something or suggests something, but a symbol does not bestow peace and power and pardon — or a new beginning for troubled hearts.



We can no more than guess what that meant to these bewildered disciples.

Jesus was saying goodbye. They knew that. But was there something more?

Was he trying to make them a promise that he was not deserting them? Was he trying to say that he was lavishing himself behind somehow so that they would never be alone?

"This is my body This is my blood."

They must have said those words over and over again to themselves in the months and years that came after, trying

walked the dusty roads of Galilee with them.

And from that time to this, ten thousand times ten thousand—have, as the Book of Common Prayer says, drawn

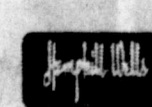

# Longhorns Deflate Raiders

Everybody in the Municipal Coliseum knew what was at stake Tuesday night — a probable third-place Southwest Conference finish.

But only the Texas Longhorns knew how to go about raking in the chips — and take a giant step towards a bye to the quarterfinals of the Southwest Conference post-season tournament in San Antonio.

The Texas cagers hit 20 of 23 free throws (13 straight at one point) and con-

nected on 51 percent of their field goal efforts to do their part while coach Abe Lemons did his part by making himself perfectly clear to the officiating crew, as the 'Horns rolled to a 76-63 win over Texas Tech and moved into the driver's seat in the battle for third place.

The Raiders, on the other hand, had their worst shooting night of the year.

connecting on only 37.1 percent of their field goal efforts and hit only 11 of 16 free throws.

The 'Horns are now 9-7 in SWC play (16-9 on the year) while Tech falls to 14-11 overall, 8-7 in league play and into a tie with Houston — which fell to Rice 81-74 Tuesday night — for fourth.

The Longhorns end the year Friday against the Owls while the Coogs face Texas A&M in their season finale, and the Raiders tangle with Arkansas.

The turning point came at the 15:13 mark of the second half when UT's John Danks was called for charging into Tech's David Little. Longhorn coach Abe

Lemons protested the call violently at mid court and had to be restrained by his players. Tech's Gerald Myers joined the melee at center court, and finally the officials had to call a time out to let things cool off.

Since no technical foul was called on either coach, the officials obviously ruled the Myers-Lemons skirmish a draw. But it was Lemons who won the battle. Over the next eight minutes, from 15:13 to 7:16, the Raiders were whistled for eight fouls while the 'Horns were only called twice.

During that eight-minute stretch, Texas expanded that lead to 55-43. Eight of the Longhorns 14 points came at the line.

"It kinda makes you wonder, doesn't it," said Myers. "One of these days I'm going to bust out and do something — say something about the officiating to the press."

"But I'm going to try and go through the proper channels," he added. "But it seems like you get better results when you just go out there and embarrass people."

"This game came close to getting out of hand," admitted Lemons. "We could've had a real Donnybrook out there. It was just something in the heat of the battle."

Also in the heat of that battle, the Longhorns repeatedly hurt the Raiders

on the fastbreak for easy buckets. Meanwhile, Tech could hit only 14 of 43 efforts in the second half (32.6 percent) as the 'Horns ran away with it. John Danks led Texas with 20 points, 14 in the first half, and LaSalle Thompson had 13 points and 14 rebounds as Texas dominated 41-34 on the boards.

Jeff Taylor was the only Raider who could provide any kind of consistent offense. Taylor had a season-high 25 points and led Tech with eight rebounds. The only other Techman in double figures was Ralph Brewster with 11 points in 26 minutes of playing time (before he fouled out).

Little hit only four of 14 shots from the field. Kent Williams was one of seven. Thad Sanders was one of five and Nelson Franse was one of four. Overall the Raiders were 26-of-70 from the field while the 'Horns were making good on 28-of-55.

"It looked like we didn't have any zip tonight," admitted Myers. "Maybe we were too emotionally high — we didn't have our legs under us. I felt bad for the seniors and the whole club because they had prepared so hard."

"Texas played a good, steady game," he added. "They seemed a little more poised. At the end we just played in a frenzy, that's about all we could do."

"This was a real good win for us."
