Army Answers Your War Problems

Q. My son has been listed as "'Missing in action." I just know he is a prisoner of war. I would like to write a letter to him that can be delivered to him as soon as he is found. Is there any place I can send this letter?

A. Do not, under any circumstances, address a letter to a soldier listed as 'missing in action," on the assumption that he is a prisoner of war. Such letters can be harmful to him if they fall into unauthorized hands.

A. He may officially protest the cayment of the family allowance out unless she agrees that it not be paid, she will continue to re-selve it as long as they are legally

Q Is there any way I can find he address of a soldier overseas? only know his name and what art of the Army he is in.

A. Yes. Write the Adjutant Jeneral, War Department, Wash-ngton, D. C. Include as much as you know of his full name, Army serial Number and organization.

Q. If a soldier is killed in ac-tion and leaves insurance made out to his grandmother, can his mother claim and get a portion of the insurance benefits?

A. Since that is a matter that must be acted upon by the Veter-ans Administration, which is not a part of the Army, it is suggest-ed that you visit or write the Vet-erans Administration office near-
