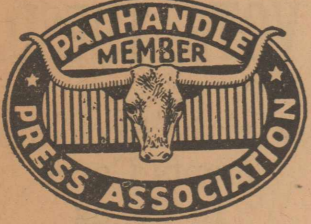

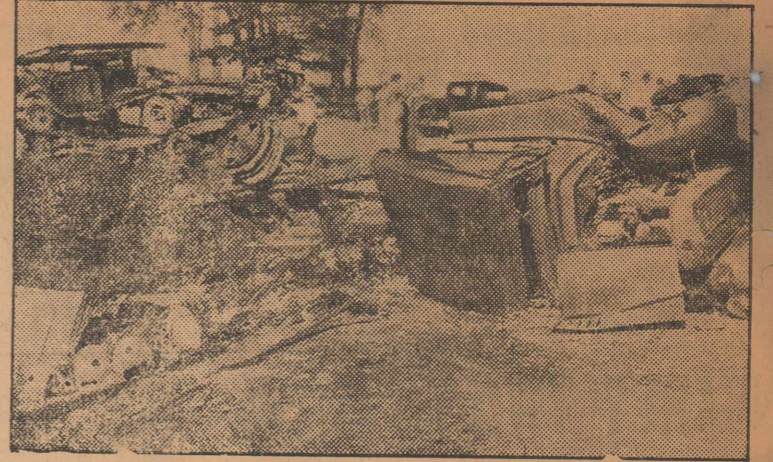
A few years ago, many of the giant airliners that operate in the Skyway of America had to be withdrawn from service every 200 hours so their motors could be completely overhauled. Bed Spreads

Here's something new in inexpensive bed spreads. Mrs. C. M. Hill, Cooperator for the Silverton Home Demonstration Club, is making a candle wick bed spread from sugar sacks. There are two rows of candle wicking where the sacks are joined together, which hides the seams. A design is candle wick in each sack. The only cost is the thread which will be approximately 70c.

Pantry News

Mrs. Grady Wimberly, Cooperator for the Lakeview Home Demonstration Club, is moving her canned food into her ventilated cellar and is organizing her food the 4-H pantry way.

"I shall plan a week in advance the foods I will need and bring enough up at one time to last a week. In this way I will be able to eliminate a lot of extra steps," Mrs. Wimberly said.

Mrs. Den Rogers, Home Food Supply Demonstrator for the San Jacinto Home Demonstration Club, improving the ventilation system is working over her storage cellar, and adding new shelves. The cellar now only has one row of shelves, which go across the back and are about two feet deep. Mr. Rogers is replacing the shelves with more narrow ones and is adding new shelves to the sides. With this new arrangement, Mrs. Rogers will have less trouble locating her foods and with the new ventilation she will be able to maintain a higher standard with her canned and stored foods.

Although the San Jacinto Club is the youngest in the county, they are by no means the least club. Mrs. Rogers is still canning and although achievement day is close at hand, she hopes to have her budget almost filled and with the canning demonstration, she will likely have it filled.

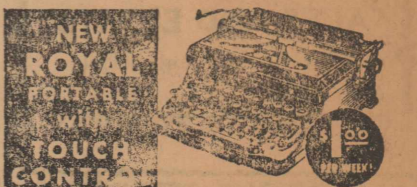

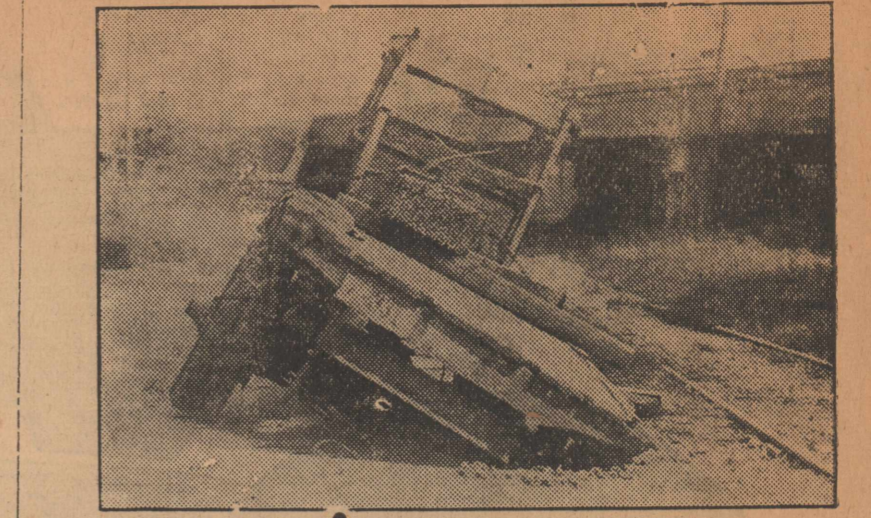

ADMIRAL GEORGE DEWEY
It was not until he was sixty that Admiral George Dewey achieved the stature of a national hero. But a lifetime of devoted service to our country in peace and war had prepared him for the moment when he became the outstanding figure of his day. Up until his great victory over the Spanish fleet in the Battle of Manila, won without loss of a single American life, Dewey's career was a progressive though unassuming advance in rank. Back of the strategy which led to the annihilation of the enemy's fleet was a lifetime of earnest preparation and many unclaimed jobs of naval heroism. The memorials to him—such as the magnificent column on Union Square in San Francisco—express his countrymen's admiration not for one flash of genius but for a rounded personality.
Admiral Dewey grew up in the American Navy. Born on December 26, 1837, at Montpelier, Vermont, he was educated at the United States Naval Academy. Montpelier, incidentally, is in the heart of our country's most important area for the production of granite and marble, the materials for monuments as enduring
as the fame of the men to whom they are dedicated. Dewey's first fighting service was in the Civil War under that distinguished seaman, Admiral Farragut.
After the Civil War, he gave conscientious service in many departments of the Navy, including several posts with Asiatic stations. At the outbreak of the Spanish-American War, Dewey was chosen to command the Asiatic fleet. On May 1, 1898, he performed the feat of destroying the Spanish fleet in Manila, and was immediately made a Rear Admiral and otherwise honored.
His homecoming in May, 1899, was a triumphal tour marked by enthusiastic popular demonstrations. To honor him, Congress revived the rank of Admiral which had been held by only two others, Farragut and David D. Porter.
Dewey lived to the ripe old age of eighty, his declining years spent in Washington, D. C., in the service of the Navy. He died on January 16, 1917, and is interred at Arlington Cemetery. There are many commemorative statues as permanent reminders of his contribution to American history.

RESULT OF OVERLOADING



Kansas City, Mo.—Taken with an overloaded tonnage of steel, here is what happened to the highway of an outer-belt road leading into Kansas City. The right rear wheel cannot be seen as it is completely submerged in the concrete slab.
So many highway accidents have occurred in this state and the need for data which may be used as a basis for determining the special road costs incurred by trucks is so great that state highway departments are now conducting surveys in several states to determine a fair charge against the trucks for the use of highways. While thousands of motor trucks daily bring about destruction of highways shown in the above illustration, it is pointed out that pleasure cars and light farm and delivery trucks stand an unjustifiable share of costs of highway upkeep.

SOILS IN TEXAS

Although more than 500 soil types have been found in Texas, making possible widely diversified crops, the State sticks to cotton as its chief crop in the face of loss of foreign markets and a steadily decreasing yield per acre and a loss in quality, according to experts advising the Texas Planning Board in its study of land uses in the State.

EARLY POSTAGE RATES

As late as the '40s postage on a letter delivered was 2 1/2 cents. It was not until 1850 that postage was reduced to 5 cents, then to 3 cents, and then to 2 cents, and letters and packages were gauged by weight. About this time the use of envelopes became legal, the practice previously being to fold the stationery.
