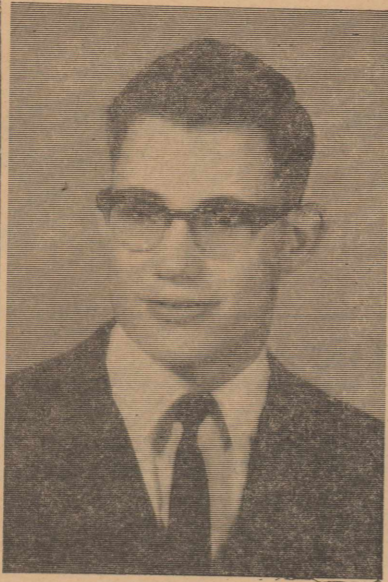

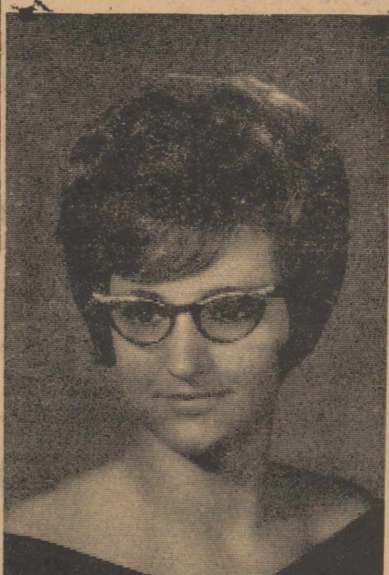


Patsy McDonald
