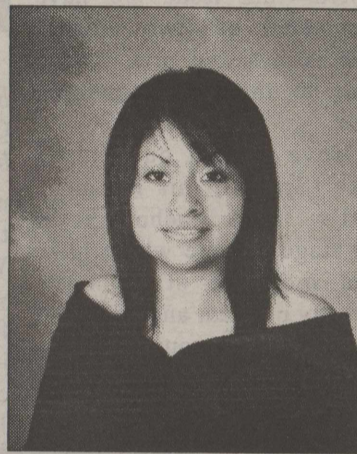

The Robert Lee City Landfill will be closed on Saturday, May 29.

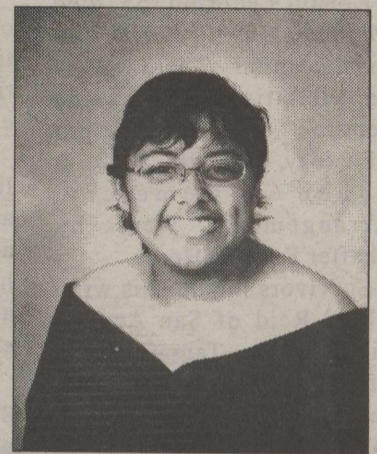
Gardening Program set for May 28

NOTICES

ORDINANCE #1194

With certain changes for the original animal ordinance adopted by the City Council of Robert Lee in June, 1997. The changes are as follows:

SECTION 3. Animals Prohibited: In most residential areas, it shall be unlawful for any person to keep any jacks, stallions, bulls, buck sheep, billy goats, pigs, boars, hogs, or any other type of swine, ostrich, rhea, emu, or any wild animal within the city limits of the City of Robert Lee.

SECTION 4. Permit Required: Any person desiring to keep livestock or poultry within the City must first obtain, and thereafter keeping in force, a permit. The procedure and requirements for the granting and keeping in force approved permits shall be as follows:

A. Application shall be in writing on a form provided for that purpose obtained by request to the office of the City Secretary. Application filed in due form shall be directed to the Code Enforcement Officer, who shall inspect the premises wherein the livestock or poultry is to be kept, and prepare an opinion as to whether the same are in compliance with the regulations herein provided.

B. The application, with the opinion of the Code Enforcement Officer attached, shall then be submitted to the City Council, which shall then pass on the application. The City Council shall consider the application, retaining the right to approve or reject the applicant. In addition, shall retain the right to revoke any livestock permit if it is found that premises are being maintained so as to constitute a public nuisance or non-compliance with the regulations set forth in this ordinance.

C. Said application among other things shall call for the name and address of applicant, number and types of livestock or poultry to be kept, description of the structures and facilities to be used for the enclosure of livestock or poultry and for the disposal of manure and debris incident to their maintenance and care, and the distance to the adjacent residence from the outside boundaries of the structure or fence in which the livestock or poultry are to be enclosed.

D. The application fee shall be accompanied by a nonrefundable fee in the amount of \$10.00.

E. Permit shall expire on March 31st following issuance, but may be renewed annually in the same manner as provided in this article.

SECTION 5. Permit Requirements: Permits may be granted and allowed to remain in force only when the regulations as follow are observed:

A. Minimum Square Footage Requirements for Pens or Enclosures and Maximum Allowable Animals: No one property shall have a pen or enclosure that shall have less than 150 square feet (12'.3" X 12'.3") per animal. All pens or enclosures shall be built so that each animal shall have at least 150 square feet for utilization.

For the purposes of this provision, the following types and numbers of livestock or poultry shall be permitted on one property: Six sheep, six goats, one cow and calf, one mule, one donkey, one horse, or 20 chickens. No other combination of the before listed animals shall be allowed.

The above stated regulations are

applicable to most residential areas. Properties located on the outer boundary of the city limits will be regulated at the discretion of the code enforcement officer and/or the city council.

SECTION 6. Limitation on Breeding Operations: There shall not be permitted in the City of Robert Lee any breeding operation of livestock and fowl.

SECTION 8. Tethered Animals: It shall be unlawful for any person to tether any livestock on any lot in the City of Robert Lee. Tethering or posting livestock shall be prohibited and is hereinafter declared unlawful.

SECTION 10. Inspection Upon Complaint: The Code Enforcement Officer may periodically on his own initiative, or upon complaint of any resident of the city, make an inspection as to whether the regulations as herein provided are being observed. It shall be unlawful to interfere with or hinder the City Official or his designee thereof, in the performance of his official duty.

SECTION 11. Notice of Violation of Ordinance: In the event there has been no corrective action taken, there shall be issued a complaint filed in the Robert Lee Municipal Court for violation of the provisions of this ordinance for which the punishment shall be a fine of not less than fifty dollars (\$50.00) nor more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) per violation, with each successive day after expiration of the last day for correction action to constitute a separate violation. Violation may result in cancellation of permit.

SECTION 14. This ordinance shall supersede Ordinance #1073.

The Effective date of this Ordinance shall be June 1, 2010.

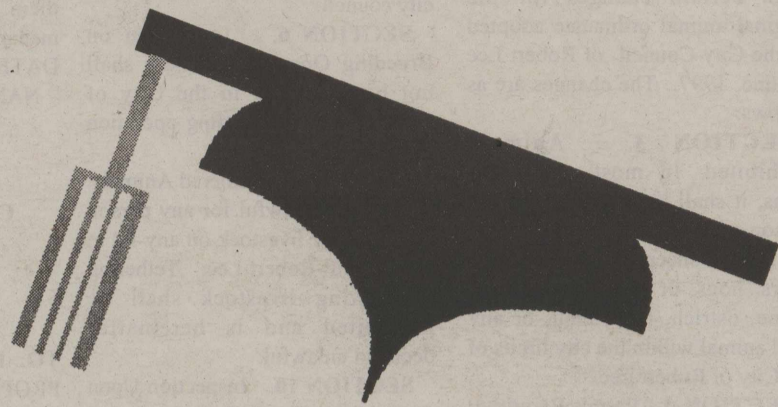
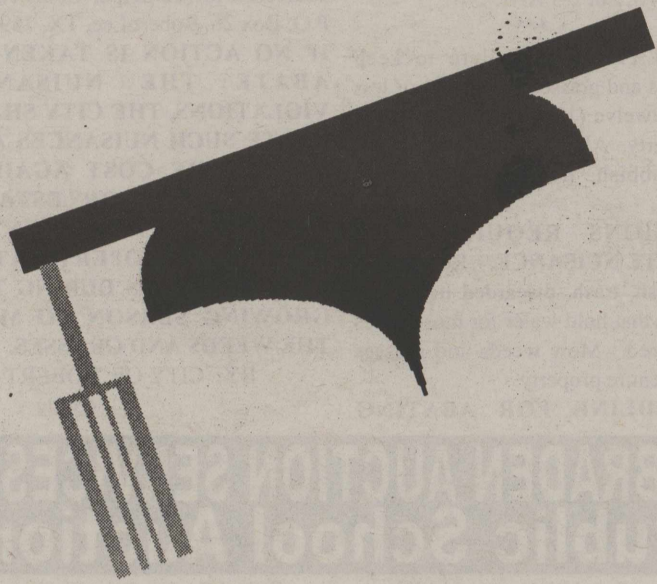
