The first volunteers were Charlotte McKnight of FUMC of Robert Lee and Pauline Brumley of Pecan Baptist Church of Robert Lee. There have been many volunteers over the years. As of this time 2 volunteers, Mary & Fred Williams, travel to San Angelo to get food from Valley the Concho Regional Food Bank. When we started out, food was purchased at .7 cents per pound. We now pay .18 cents a pound and desserts are free food. This is purchased on Tuesday morning and shelves are re-stocked by Mary, Fred and Delores Roe. We are

open Wednesday from 2 pm to 4 pm.

Each recipient is given a cloth bag to fill when they first come to the food pantry, they are to bring each time they come. The bread & desserts are placed in a plastic grocery sack. We allow each recipient to do their own shopping and volunteers to do the sacking.

The food pantry has been in operation 12 years now. We have from 21-40 recipients each Wednesday. The need seems to be greater and greater as people have lost their jobs or have hours cut.

The holidays are coming soon and we need help funding Holiday Foods. We do accept memorials, cash donations, and food donations. There are times the schools have a food drive. individuals donate and clean out freezers and etc. This is a great help.

As of 2012 we are required to have each client fill out a client screening form. This is a federal law and USDA policy. This institution is prohibited from discrimination on basis of race, color, national origin, age or disability.

We would like to personally thank all of you who have made donations in the form of money, food and memorials. It has been a great help, we don't want anyone in Coke County to
