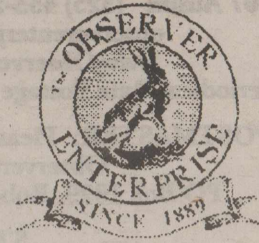

Republican incumbent Dan Patrick is being challenged by Democrat Mike Collier and Libertarian Kerry Douglas McKennon in the election for Texas Lieutenant Governor.

In the election for Texas Attorney General, Republican incumbent Ken Paxton is being challenged by Democrat Justin Nelson and Libertarian Michael Ray Harris.

Republican incumbent Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts Glenn Hegar is being challenged by Democrat Joi Chevalier and Libertarian Ben Sanders.

Republican incumbent George P. Bush is being challenged by Democrat Miguel Suazo and Libertarian Matt Pina in the election for

Commissioner of the General Land Office.

In the election for Texas Commissioner of Agriculture, Republican incumbent Sid Miller is being challenged by Democrat Kim Olson and Libertarian Richard Carpenter.

Republican incumbent Christi Craddick is being challenged by Democrat Roman McAllen and Libertarian Mike Write in the election for Texas Railroad Commissioner.

**'64 Study Club meeting held**

The '64 Study Club met on Monday, October 8, 2018, for their monthly meeting, with Steve Salmon as the speaker. He presented the facts and figures needed to secure an emergency medical service for Coke County. There are many issues that must be worked out among city, county, state, and federal agencies. The EMS can become a taxation entity, a county entity, a volunteer entity, or an endowed entity, all of which require time, effort, and study.

As of now, it is a matter of volunteers. Many volunteers have served, and served, and served some more because of their dedication to the job. The burden becomes heavy when there are so few serving.

The '64 Study Club learned that out of 20 volunteers beginning the \$1,000 training, usually only four or five complete the program for

various personal reasons. Completion of the training looks good on a job application, and prepares a trainee to handle many emergencies for which they receive eternal gratitude - but no pay.

Another problem that was pointed out is that over time, many set rules and regulations change, and become more stringent, requiring new equipment and more training. Many of the regulations are intended for big city EMS organizations. The necessity for EMS in rural areas cannot be overlooked. Emergencies affect all levels of citizens. The facts are available. A way to approach the need is through discussion on many levels of the community and government agencies.

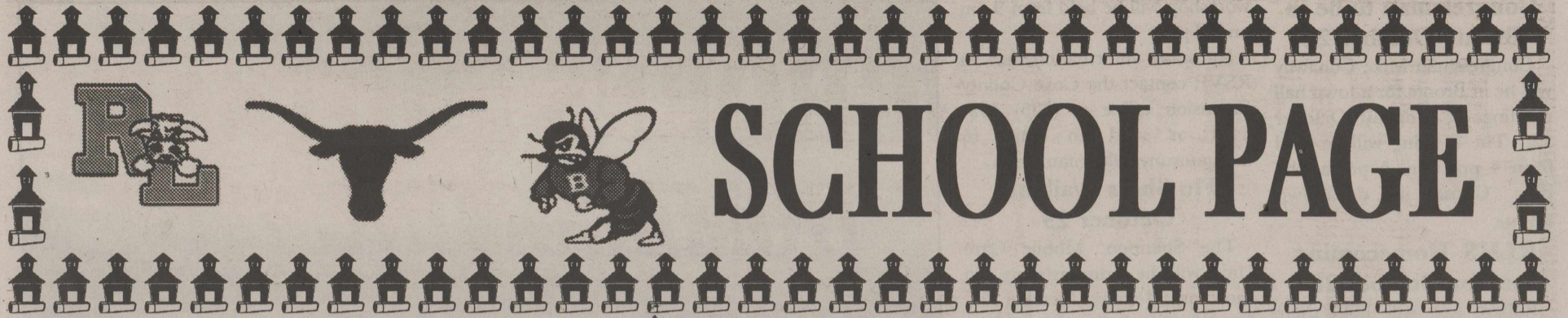

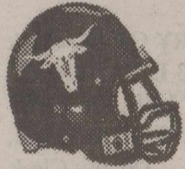

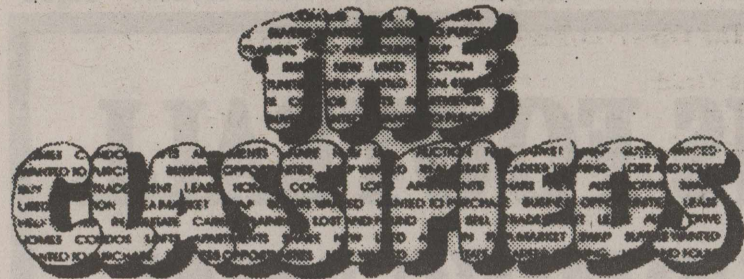

Bronte and Robert Lee students met at the historic Fort Chadbourne, located on US Highway 277 with its famous giant spur entrance. Their day of hands on learning began at 9 am.

Station One was the Visitor's

Center tour by Ann Pate and Garland and Lana Richards. The students were able to experience the tight quarters of a stage coach ride, examine artifacts recovered from the grounds, and wave at a friendly ghost named Maggie.

The Stream Trailer at Station Two was hosted by Morgan Runyan, Agri-Life Extension Agent, and Winton Milliff, Coke County Underground Water Conservation District. The trailer used tiny pieces of plastic and water to demonstrate how the water travels across the land. The students were able to get hands on at this station, creating different paths for the water to move through and how it affected the "soil".

into three groups. One group saddled up inside the theater to watch a portion of a film about the fort. Another group stayed under the pavilion to watch a demonstration on how pollutants can leak into our drinking water and enjoyed an edible aquifer dessert. The third group loaded up and took off in search of buffalo. Each group rotated until they were able to enjoy all three of the activities.

Fort Chadbourne provided a great setting with beauty and history for the volunteers and teachers to help make this day come together with ease.
