Dr. Frank Spencer Spends Three Weeks As Instructor In Australian Hospital

Dr. Frank Spencer, specialist in heart surgery in John Hopkins Hospital, Baltimore, Md., and son of Mrs. Frank Spencer of Haskell, recently returned from a three weeks stay in Sydney, Australia. Dr. Spencer and a fellow surgeon from John Hopkins, Dr. Hank Bahnsen, went to Sydney to instruct the staff of the Royal Prince Alfred Cardiac Institute in the use of the newly-developed heart pump, first used in heart surgery at the Baltimore hospital.

On his return trip to the states, Dr. Spencer stopped in Dallas briefly and his plane was met by Mrs. Spencer and Mr. and Mrs. George Tyler of this city. They visited with Dr. Spencer, who is a brother of Mrs. Tyler, for more than an hour between planes before he resumed his flight to Baltimore.

The Australian government paid the plane fare and expenses of Dr. Spencer and Dr. Bahnsen for the trip to Sydney and return in order that the specialists might instruct Australian surgeons in use of the newly developed facility used in complicated heart surgery. The unit was purchased from John Hopkins Hospital and shipped to Australia in July.

When the two American surgeons arrived in Australia, there

comment that slowed us down a bit, but we operated on our first two patients yesterday with a good result; so things are well under way.

"Because of the delay, I moved my travel schedule back two days to Friday the 29th, and will fly home, non-stop to Baltimore. Hank will stay about 10 days longer.

"This is their summer here. January and February are their hottest months. Today was about 100 degrees. Tonight a "southerly" blew in from the South Pole and the temperature dropped to 50. I told them in Texas that we called this a "norther."

Soil Management Important For Top Production

Good soil management practices and well adapted cropping systems are the basis for a long continued and prosperous agriculture. Those who depend on the soil for livelihood are likely to become careless with this main resource, and this can prove costly, warns Jack Barton, soil extension conservation specialist at College Station.

The physical condition of soil is of much importance in crop production, says Barton. Physical properties can be controlled by good use of crop residues, crop rotations, green manure and cover crops and barnyard manure. A deep, moderately porous soil should be maintained, rather than one that is too tight and hard to work or the other extreme, too porous.

Organic matter is of prime importance in keeping soil in good physical condition. It insures a good population of beneficial soil bacteria, aids in water penetration, increases the water-holding capacity of the soil, improves soil structure and adds nitrogen and humus.

Texas soils are likely to be deficient in nitrogen, phosphorous,

potash and lime, so in many instances fertilization is necessary to insure maximum yields. The addition of these essential plant nutrients can result in much higher production.
