

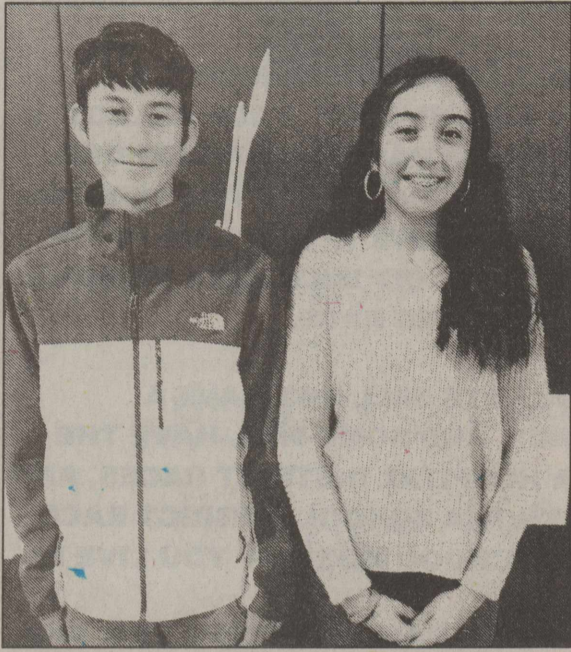

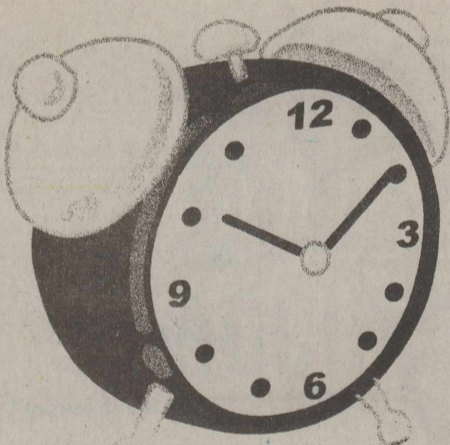
## Good Luck to Justin & Janeht

## NOTICE TO VOTERS

I have had calls asking about the postings on social media stating the marks on ballots in the U. S. Senators Race being changed before the ballot is cast. First of all: All voting machines are not the same example FORD, CHEVY and HONDA are not the same cars. The State of Texas has certified 3 different voting machines,

Diebold TSX (the ones we have).

2. Hart eSlate, has a rotary dial, very easy to make a mistake.

3. ES&S AutoMark.

In addition to different machines, the county can either purchase the programming software or contract with a 3rd party to program the ballots. There are multiple 3rd party vendors that do the programming. I have done the programming on our machines since they were purchased in 2006 except for the 2018 primary and runoff. Testing is required to be done before the machines are voted on by anyone if the machines don't pass the test you have to start over with the programming. Our machines are not connected to the internet at any time and cannot be "hacked" as widely reported by some media outlets. My programming computer is not connected to the internet at any time either and a printer prints out a log of every key stroke that is made in that software.

An investigation has been done in the cases reported and the results reflect VOTER ERROR not the machine changing the votes. No one is perfect, and mistakes can be made, and machines can malfunction but the Election Officials in the State of Texas (including me) make every effort to make it as perfect as anyone can. Unfortunately, when there is a problem instead of going to the source people would rather spread the word and make someone look bad instead of helping to solve the problem.

I would like to invite anyone who has a concern to come to the testing on Friday, November 2, 2018, from 2 to 4 PM. I will be glad to show you how the mistakes are made and how to make sure the vote you cast is the vote that is recorded.

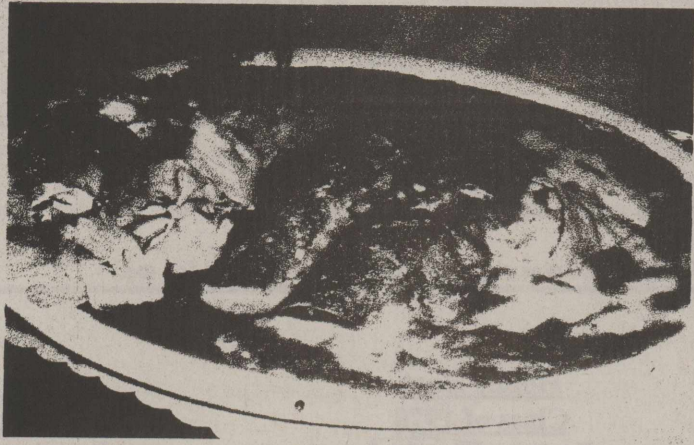

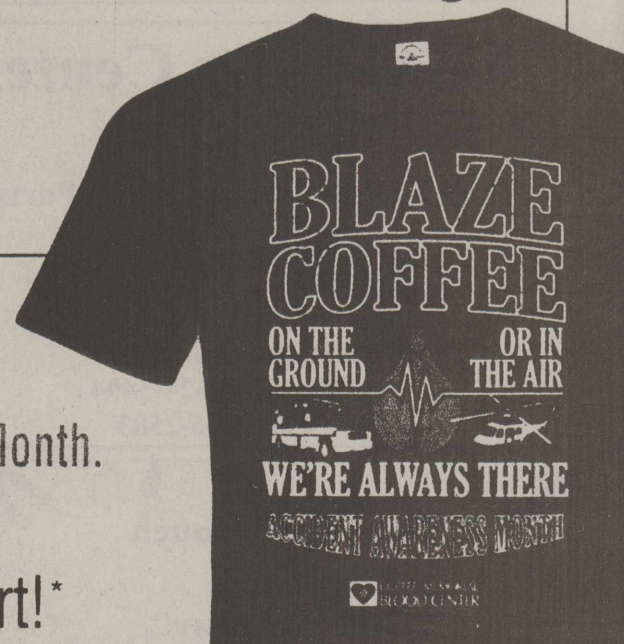



## Help Wanted

### Job brief

We are looking for a competent Director of Maintenance & Security to manage maintenance in our facilities for the Stratford Hospital District. You will be solely responsible for ensuring the smooth running of upkeep or repair of each operation apart of the hospital district.

An excellent maintenance supervisor must be reliable and have a great eye for detail. They must have technical skills and knowledge of various crafts such as carpentry, landscaping, plumbing etc. Leadership and knowledge of administrative tasks such as scheduling are also essential.

The goal is to ensure that facilities apart of the hospital district are in a good and safe condition at all times.

### Responsibilities

- Inspect facilities periodically to determine problems and necessary maintenance
- Prepare weekly maintenance list based on work orders and request

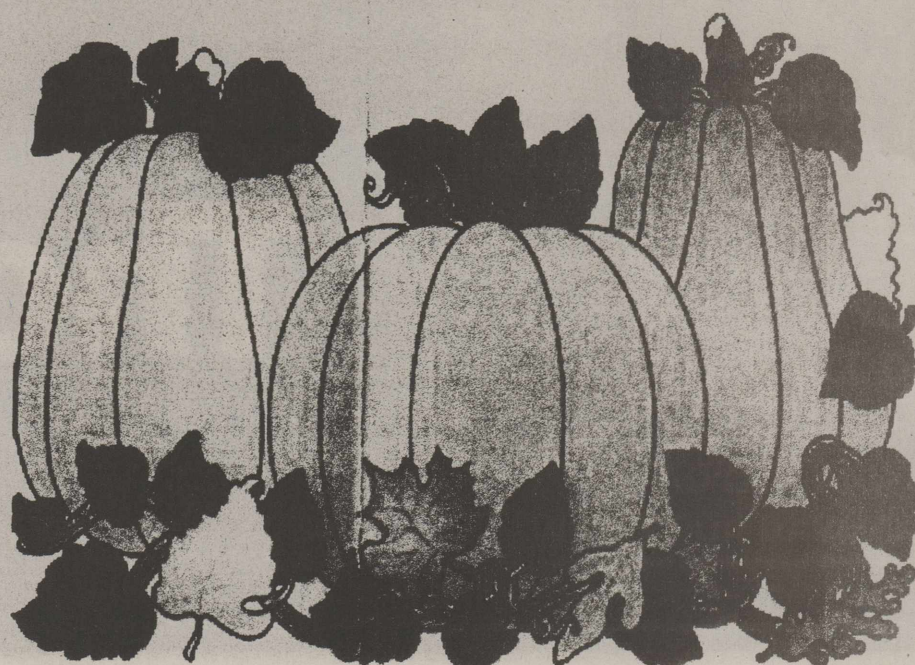

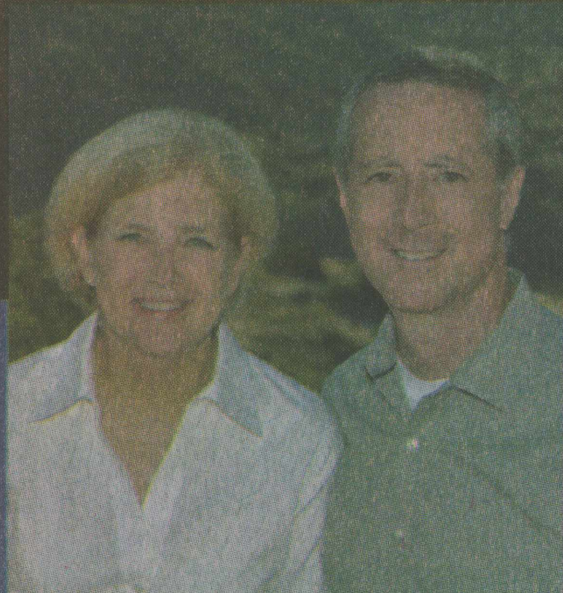
