Time Out With Rog

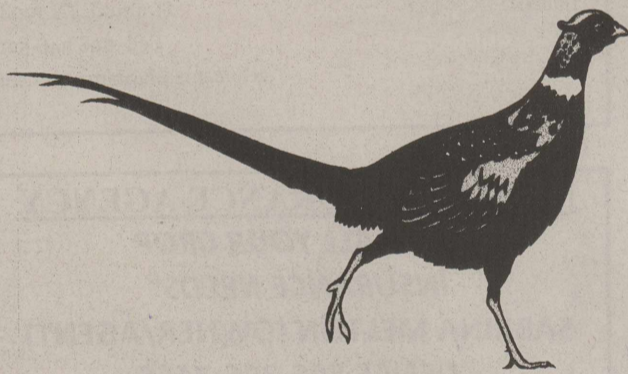
