

GINGERBREAD STAR COOKIES

1 18 oz. tube refrigerated sugar cookie dough 1/2 cup dark molasses 1 cup flour

1 tbsp. ground ginger Dreyer's/Edy's® Grand **Peppermint Ice Cream** Colored sugar sprinkles (optional) **Prepared** icing

To store longer than two hours, place sandwiches in airtight container or wrap each in plastic.
