## 4-H State Roundup was a Success for the Skillathon Team

A team of four Sherman County 4-H members competed in the Livestock Skillathon competition on Tuesday, June 7th, in College Station, Texas. The team placed 3rd overall and consisted of Nick Payne, Raeleigh Willborn, Jaci Brown, and Bret Barnard. They studied long and hard for a competition that included Identifying Retail Cuts, Retail Beef Placing, Industry Equipment Identification, Forage Evaluation, Livestock Breed and Origin Identification, Quality Counts worksheet and problem, Wool Quality, and took a quiz over the Livestock Industry. Bret placed 7th in Swine and Vt in Sheep & Goat, which left him in 7th place individual overall! Raeleigh Willborn placed 9th in Sheep & Goat as an individual. As a team of four, they placed 7th in Beef, 2nd in Swine, and 2nd in Sheep & Goat, which like I said earlier, left them with a placing of 31d overall at State! Way to go Sherman County!
