



Call to Order and Pledge of Allegiance

Mayor Reed called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm and led the Pledge of

Consent Agenda Items

- a. Minutes from regular meeting on March 28, 2017
- b. Accounts Payable for March 2017
- Financial Statements for March 2017
 - o Ann Johnson motioned to approve as presented, Joe Zak seconded, all in favor, motion carried.

Council Business

- a. Discuss and consider action re: request by West Texas Gas re: Right-of-Way
 - o Billy Hawkins to present
 - Western Gas Interstate is the name of the pipeline company. Mr. Hawkins was present to request 20' of right-of-way from the City at a rate of \$80/rod. He explained that a rod is 16 1/2'. He stated that they would need an extra 14'x14' for a booster station. He explained that construction would be under the powerlines and a 4" valve will be installed above ground by the fence. After some discussion regarding some alternate options, Mr. Hawkins thanked the Council for their time and will return to discuss options. No action was taken at this time.
- b. Discuss and consider corrective action for minutes from February 28, 2017 regular meeting
 - o Joe Zak motioned to approve, Kyle Sandvig seconded, all in favor,
- Discuss and consider action re: 2018 Appraisal District Budget
 - o After some discussion, Ann Johnson motioned to approve, Kyle Sandvig seconded, all in favor, motion carried.
- d. Discuss and consider action re: extending permits for new construction to one (1) year
 - o Joe Zak motioned to approve for new house/commercial construction only, Ann Johnson seconded, all in favor, motion approved.
- Discuss and consider action re: RESOLUTION NO. 2017-04R(1) denying surcharge submitted by Southwestern Public Service on about April 6, 2017
 - o Joe Zak motioned to approve the resolution, Ann Johnson seconded, all in favor, motion carried

- Discuss and consider action re: RESOLUTION NO. 2017-04R(2) opposing the enactment of SB 1515 and SB 1004
 - o Mobilite is aggressively pursuing Panhandle cities for right-of-way access. The Resolution is being submitted in hopes of slowing or

stopping this "invasion". Joe Zak motioned to approve, Ann Johnson seconded, all in favor, motion carried.

City Manager Report

- Received notice that the permit for the hog farm is progressively moving forward.
- Received a backflow preventer violation from TCEQ. It was brought to our attention that this preventer became a requirement 12 years ago. The City must pass an ordinance to perform inspections on private property. Code Enforcement will monitor compliance and testing.
- He attended an Emergency Management meeting and asked about getting some information on grants available for storm shelters.
- Well #3 has had repairs. A new pump was installed. The first pump blew out about one year ago. The 2nd pump lasted approximately two months and failed as well. The City has contacted Xcel Energy about an electrical failure. Xcel did perform some repairs to the transformer for a "floating ground problem". The City will submit a claim to Xcel regarding this issue.

Citizen Comment Period

There were no comments.

Items from the Council

- Joe Zak commented/questioned re:
 - O Stickney repair, closure of the old sewer plant, bids for clean-up for old concrete plant
- Kyle Sandvig reported that he had some water testing done for a water softener system.
- Ann Johnson commented/questioned re:
 - Installation of sirens, community clean-up for cemetery, fence repairs at Roxy Park, pot holes before and after railroad in front of the cemetery
- Ricky Reed commented regarding hot mix on Purnell.

 Joe Zak motioned to adjourn at 6:56 pm, Ann Johnson seconded, all in favor, motion carried.




