topdressing. Nitrogen deficien green in color appear yellow ceings to actively grow. If th sunshine, you can be reasonab inadequate nitrogen.

Dryland fields should be nitrogen. Irrigated wheat fields
that are showing deficiency ymptoms should receive at leas
an initial application of 60 pounds an be applied nitrogen. The nitrogen mmonium nitrate dry form as sulfate, urea, or as nitrogen
