Administrative Cost Of Social Security Is Low The Social Security tax rate
remains the same in 1952 as was remains the same in 1952 as wa last year, accorging to H. M
Cleveland, Manager of the Socia Securit Administration in Corpu
Christi. Christi. Employees and their employer
each pay $11 / 2 \%$ of wages, and the
self-employed pay $2 \% \%$ of their self-employed pay $21 / \% \%$ of their
net earnings for social security.
Under the old-age and survivors Under the old-age and survivors
insurance provisions, the tax ap-
lies to wages and net earnings hies wages and net earning
up to $\$ 3,600$ a year.
When questioned ancing provisions of the insurance
system, Cleveland explained that system, Cleveland explained that
Social Security taxes have amounted to more than the benefits paid
each year to date. In 1951, taxe each year to to $\$ 3.4$ billion wer
amounting to
collected, and total benefit pay collected, and total benef
ments were $\$ 1.9$ billion.

fits goes into a trust fund that
is invested only in interest is invested only in interest bearing
