| Jill represent Aransas County and E. C. Drumb, city manager, David Grose, city attorney, and C. H. Marks, hydraulic engineer, will represent the City of Alice at a hearing scheduled by the State Board of Water Engineers for 10 a . m . October 16 in Uvalde County Courthouse, on the proposed master plan of the Nueces River Conservation and Reclamation District. <br> "We don't intend to oppose it," Drumb said, "but we are going to ask the State Engineers to hold 200,000 acre feet in abeyance for future need by cities in the Lower Basin of the Nueces." <br> Freese and Nichols, consulting engineers, worked up the plan for the District, which was resuscitated four years ago after many years of inacivity. Directors of the district have concluded that it will help local agencies build the eservoirs in any way possible, reservoirs in any way possibie, but that responsibility for building those needed must rest on the communities benefiting. <br> The District Board held a public hearing in San Antonio in December last year. <br> Aransas County's interest stems from the fact that, in the not too distant future the only unfailing source of water in the area may be the Nueces River. <br> Art Show to Be November 20-22 <br> The Rockport School of F'ne Arts has decided upon dates for its fall show, according to Director Simon C.
