here now. If you think a little competition will improve the price and service in this field this is our chance to show it by uniting in this effort. As you know, we usually ask what will you give for what we sell and what will you take for what we buy. P. C. A. and R.E.A. have shown how this can improve our lot.

We think this is to the interest of every grain producer in Haskell County and have been working for it, but we either can't find you at home or you have a good excuse for not investing in it. If you have to borrow the money to put into it, as most of us do, the difference between $5^{* /}$ you receive from the preferred stock (all over \$25) and the amount of interest you have to pay is only $\$ 3$ or $\$ 4$ per hundred, so if you are out $\$ 15$ or $\$ 20$ on $\$ 500$ investment per year and if you sell 300 bushels of grain and receive 10 cents per bushel more you are ahead $\$ 10$ already.
