Fifteen Year Old Lists Limousin Achievements

By Wendy Milford For most people, saying that you own 25 head of registered Limousin cattle in addition to market steers, calves, show heifers and bulls would be saying a lot. And if you are a 15year old girl that is saying a whole lot!

For Tracy Hicks of Blossom, it's just an every day head count of her cattle herd. Tracy has been raising registered Limousin cattle ever since her father started in the business in 1979. She has also been showing cattle since she was eight years old.

"I showed in the kiddy class with kids who all had little calves and rabbits," Tracy said, "and there I was with a two year old heifer!"

After that early win in the kiddy class at the Paris Junior Livestock Show, Tracy was hooked. What started as a show heifer has bloomed into a prosperous business, as well as a project program for 4-H and FFA.

Tracy's cattle are not only numerous for a person her age, but they are also very good.

Tracy's bull, Comanche, won Reserve Champion at the Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo.

"It surprised me since I was competing against all the big ranches," Tracy said.

She has also had the Grand Champion Bull at the Louisiana State Junior Show and won six silver cups for her heifers as well. Two weeks ago

she won Grand Champion with her bull at the Texas Club Calf Association Show held in Paris.

Perhaps the award she is most proud of is a resolution from the Texas House of Representatives. The resolution recognizes her accomplishments in the cattle business.

Tracy is an active member of the Texas Junior Limousin Association and served as secretary-treasurer last year. This year, Tracy will serve as

vice-president of the organization. Tracy is also a member of the North American Junior Limousin Foundation and the Texas Club Calf Association.

But Tracy's activities are not limited to her cattle. She is also an active member of the Prairiland FFA Chapter. She was a member of the Greenhand Chapter Conducting Team that competed at the District and Area levels. She also was named Star Greenhand for the Paris District and placed second in the area. After they get all that done they can go out to their desk and pound out the cutlines to go under the pictures, then write the story to accompany it.

Weekly people have something to mpensate for most of that, though. at's the trust and, usually, affection, of the people in their community.

There isn't much respect, no one considers that weekly people have any great talent, nor does a picture on the front page of a weekly have the same prestige (or pay) of a huge city daily.

Crime Stoppers Has Been Successful





Lyndal Whitt To Be Honored



worm can be found near a fence row, building or clump of trees. The worms begin eating the blades of the grass as soon as they hatch, and early damaged grass has an ash grey appearance. This appearance is due to the rasping of the small worms.

There are several chemicals approved in pastures and meadows. Five formulations of Sevin-XLR, 4 oil 80S, 50W and 4F and Dibrom, Malathion and Parathion are approved for control of armyworms. Dylox can be used for grasshopper control. Follow the instructions on the label for grazing and haying restrictons. If Sevin is appled by ground rig there is a 14 day wait and no wait if applied aerially. Dylox, Dibrom and Malathion have no time wait when grazed but a7 day wait where Dibrom is used on grass to be hayed.


Worm activity is not limited to

targets of the worm. Chemicals that are labeled for use include Orthene

by fungi growing on organic substances such as corn which, when consumed have some undesirable effect on the animal.

There is no way to take care of the fungi once present on the grain. However, there are a number of management practices that can help reduce theproblem. One should harvest as soon as possible. Dry com immediately if moisture is greater than 13% as Aflatoxin production ceases at 13 percent. Aflatoxin is more prevalent in damaged kernels, so cylinder speed can be reduced and other adjustments made to prevent cracking and havesting damaged kernels.

Fields that have been severely stressed by the drought are more apt to be contaminated with the Aflatoxin. These fields or areas may be harvested separate. As one can see, few options are available to theproducer with Aflatoxin contaminated pastures and meadows. Fertilized corn, other than to bury it. Aflatoxin lawns and athletic fields can also be infested corn will have a greenish tint to the kernels as opposed to a black smut.








