We treked down to the basement in search of rest rooms. It was in the basement that the strangely famliar scent became strong enough for me to identify. Our state's capitol building smelled of Pine Oil Cleaner! I have no doubt that our nation's capitol smells the same way. This building smells exactly like very courthouse I've ever been in.

No, I haven't made a habit of appearing in court at the courthouse over the years. No unpaid parking tickets, no fines, no charges.

However we've stopped to wander through a lot of the historic and magnificent old structures throughout the nation.

Invariably, there are several scents that remain the same. That peculiar blend of pine oil cleanser, chalk dust (where does that come from?) dusty paper, old stone and carved wood.

It is very similiar to the smell of school halls. Schools smell of chalk, pine cleaner and gym shoes. Even though many schools are new, brick and glass structures, they still have



Cotton, No Longer King, Still Royal!

By Nanalee Nichols Cotton hasn't been "King" throughout Red River and Lamar Counties for a lot of years. It never was King down in Talco, where Black Gold has been the undisputed economic ruler since the 1930's.

Cotton, indeed, fell from it's spot as the south's major agriculture product, along about the time Baron Soy Bean and Duke Milo began taking some hefty chunks of land for their production.

Still, cotton is a royal crop, and provides a lot of economic income to the area.

Indeed, it is easy to forget, in an age of high tech work and big industrial plants, just how much income is provided from agriculture within this area

Things have changed, of course.

production as it has every other facet of life.

The brilliantly colored hoardes of migrant workers, black, white and hispanic, no longer flood into the fields at the end of August to make their slow way down row after row "pulling bolls".

Airplanes or spray bombs put out chemicals to cause the cotton plants to drop their leaves.

Cotton harvesting, perhaps more than any other crop, is something of a family affair.

Then enormous strippers rumble down the rows, dumping or spitting their snowy cargo into trailers, or, even more recently, having them compressed into a module that contains ten bales of cotton.

Cotton harvest used to mean that every town kept every business open late on Saturday night, even (or especially) the banks.

Farmers came into town with their mule-drawn wagons and had cash money for perhaps the only time during the year.



PUBLIC NOTICE BRIEF EXPLANATORY STATEMENTS OF PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS **GENERAL ELECTION NOVEMBER 8, 1988**

PROPOSITION NO. 1 ON THE BALLOT

Senate Joint Resolution 8 proposes a constitutional amendment providing that when the federal vernment reimburses the state for penditures of state funds dedicated to acquiring rights-of-way and for constructing, maintaining, and policing public roadways, such federal funds must also be used for those purposes.

The proposed amendment will appear on the ballot as follows:

"The constitutional amendment and/or clarification providing that federal reimbursement of state highway dedicated funds are themselves dedicated for the purpose of acquiring rights-of-way and constructing, maintaining, and policing public roadways."

PROPOSITION NO. 2 ON THE BALLOT

House Joint Resolution 2 proposes onstitutional amendment to estaban economic stabilization fund In the state treasury. The fund would consist of one half of the unencumbered balance of general revenues at the end of a biennium and three fourths of the difference between the net oil and gas production taxes received in a fiscal year and the net oil and gas production taxes received in the 1987 fiscal year. During any fiscal biennium, the amount in the economic stabilization fund could not exceed 10% of the total deposited in general revenue in the preceding biennium.

The state comptroller and the state treasurer could decide to trans- funds from other sources. The Texas

fer monies from the fund into the general revenue fund to alleviate a temporary cash shortage in general revenue. The legislature could make appropriations from the fund on approval by a three fifths vote of each house to make up the difference between anticipated general revenue and appropriations. On approval of two thirds of the members of each house of the legislature, the legislature could appropriate monies from the fund for any purpose.

The proposed amendment will appear on the ballot as follows:

"The constitutional amendment establishing an economic stabilization fund in the state treasury to be used to offset unforeseen shortfalls in revenue."

PROPOSITION NO. 3 ON THE BALLOT

House Joint Resolution 5 proposes a constitutional amendment that establishes the Texas growth fund. All investments of the Texas growth fund must be directly related to furthering economic growth and employment opportunities in Texas. At least 50 percent of the fund must be invested in equity and/or debt security for the initial construction, expansion, or modernization of business or industrial facilities in Texas. Not more than ten percent of the fund may be invested venture capital investments. Of the funds available for venture capital investments, not more than 25 percent may be invested unilaterally, and the remaining investments must be matched at least equally by

growth fund will be managed by a board of trustees consisting of four members appointed by the Governor and one member from and elected by the membership of each of the following: The Board of Regents of the University of Texas System; The Board of Regents of the Texas A&M System; The Board of Trustees of the Teacher's Retirement System of Texas; The Board of Trustees of the Employee's Retirement System of Texas; and the State Board of Education. The trustees may set the investment policy of the fund, enter into investment contracts, and take any action necessary for the creation, administration, and protection of the fund. The amendment authorizes the Board of Regents of the University of Texas System and the State Board of Education, in managing the permanent university fund and the permanent school fund, to acquire, exchange, sell, supervise, manage, or retain any kind of investment, including investments in the Texas growth fund. The fund will be phased out after the tenth anniversary of its creation, but the Legislature may create a second growth fund by a two thirds vote of each house.

The proposed amendment will appear on the ballot as follows:

"The constitutional amendment to provide for the investment of the permanent university fund, the permanent school fund, and public employee retirement systems in the Texas growth fund created by the amendment, which will directly create, retain, and expand job opportunity and eco-nomic growth in Texas."






