Donley/Wheeler Joint County Broadband Initiative

WHO is involved?



The Donley & Wheeler Counties' Joint Broadband Committee is comprised of local community leaders from various sectors with a common mission of enhancing and expanding broadband **access, adoption** and **use** throughout the county for the benefit of local residents and businesses. To that end, the Committee has partnered with Connected Nation Texas and their "Connected Community" program to assess the present state of broadband in Donley and Wheeler Counties and establish a broadband planning process and plan to address our current and future broadband needs.

WHAT is being done?

To perform an assessment of Donley and Wheeler Counties' current broadband environment, the Committee will be conducting surveys of local residents, businesses and other organizations across the county. Responses to these surveys will help us better understand the existing resources and capabilities we now have to support our **access, adoption** and **use** of broadband technology in our homes and businesses. After a structured evaluation of this assessment, we'll then develop appropriate action plans and projects to improve our broadband environment most effectively.

WHEN will this take place?

Our Joint Community Broadband Assessment and related surveys will be launched in August and continue into the November timeframe. Results from this work will be shared with the public, followed by additional work to develop a county-wide Action Plan to address identified areas of need.

HOW can you help?

Your participation in the appropriate broadband survey and overall support of our efforts are very important in developing an accurate assessment of broadband availability and related needs in Donley and Wheeler Counties. 




