And so it is for everyone else as well. It is tempting to want to solve the problems of others, even if the problems really are universal in their scope, but that is a disordered approach. Any man must solve his own problem, and establish order for himself, before he can begin to consider inducing order upon anyone else. Several phrases come to mind; among them, "Remove the plank from your eye so you can clearly see to remove the splinter from your brother's."

It turns out that if you want to make the world a more beautiful place, start by cleaning REPORT your house. Mow your lawn. And get your world in order before bothering much with disorder observed in others.







USDA is implementing ERP as a two-phased program, with the first phase utilizing existing claim data to provide relief expediently, and the second phase focusing on ensuring producers not covered by other programs receive assistance. For phase one, USDA used crop insurance and Noninsured Crop Disaster Assistance Program (NAP) claim data.

Both ERP and the previously announced Emergency Livestock Relief Program (ELRP) are funded by the Extending Government Funding and Delivering Emergency Assistance Act, which President Biden signed into law in 2021. The law provided \$10 billion to help agricultural producers with NAP coverage in midimpacted by wildfires, July.

> ERP provisions allow for a higher payment percentage for historically underserved including producers, beginning, limited resource, socially disadvantaged and military veteran producers. To qualify for the higher payment rate, individuals must have a Form CCC-860. Socially Disadvantaged, Limited Resource, Beginning and Veteran Farmer or Rancher Certification on file.

To receive a payment, producers must complete and submit their forms by the July 22 deadline. Once the completed ERP application for payment is submitted to and signed by the FSA, producers enrolled in direct deposit should look for their payment within three business days.
