There seems to be a universal law of entropy at work, which by default pulls mannatural world, downward unless it is struggled against, and this struggle must take place on a regular, or continual basis. The only other way to avoid this entropic movement is by the assistance of a wind which we did not generate, earn, or deserve, and which lifts our sails and enables us to move for a while, through minimal effort of our own. Still, one must be found at sea if catching such a wind is to be of benefit.

The difficulty of resuming motion after momentum has stalled is the reason I dislike lunch breaks during the day, and yet the hunger cues are themselves a sort of plea to preserve momentum, in the form of the body replenishing the energy it has exhausted. I suppose this break for lunch may be a matter of perspective about a matter of necessity. And perspective, like movement and effort, can ride the wave of momentum, and spiral upon itself either to the good or to the ill. Choose your set well.
