second trump. Then she cashed the ace of trumps, returned to her hand with a third trump, and led a low club for the winning finesse of the ten. But there was still the club loser and a possible spade loser to be reckoned with.

Mrs. Daub continued by cashing the ace and king of diamonds and ruffing the third diamond. She then cashed the king of clubs and led the fourth club. East was forced in with nothing but spades to return. Thus North made both the ace and queen, and dummy's last trump took care of the three-spot.

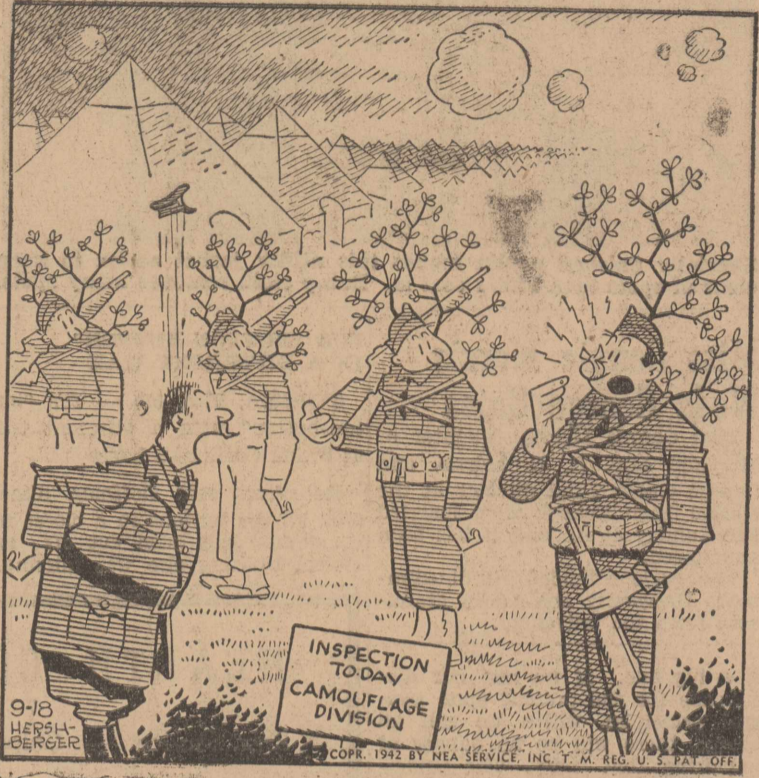
IMPRACICAL JOKESTER GIVES SCHOOL CHILDREN A HOLIDAY
