The president's pair event was won by Dr. Kalman Apfel and P. P. Begley of New York. A nice play gave Dr. Apfel top score on one of the hands in the contest. Sitting East, he won the opening lead and led a spade for a winning finesse. He returned with a second club lead to lead another trump, and one more round exhausted South.

Now Dr. Apfel led a low diamond from dummy, and when North played low, the jack forced the ace. As pointed out by Dr. Apfel, this finesse is as good as a lead toward the king, if the position of the ace and queen is unknown. While it looks strange here where South is placed with the ace by the bidding, it worked and it had the desired effect on South. Thinking that East had the queen of diamonds and that the suit was solid, South laid down the ace of hearts in the desperate hope that North had the king.

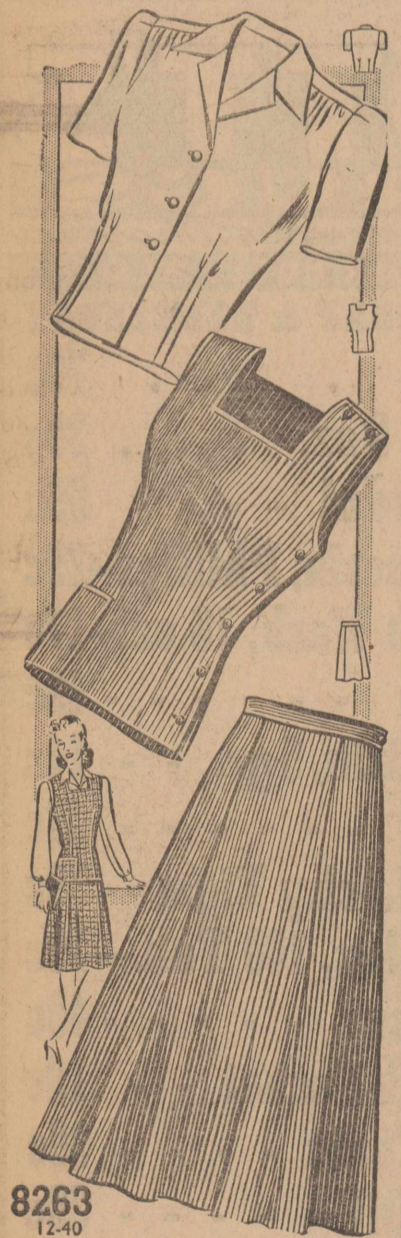
L. A. Delaney Dies, To Be Buried In Abilene

Julius Armstrong Now Stationed At Ft. Bliss

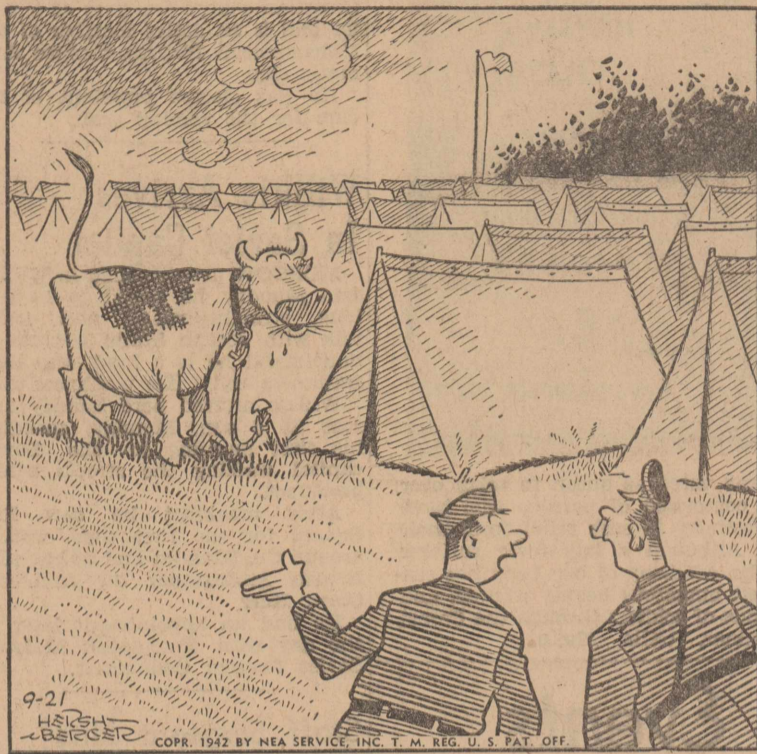

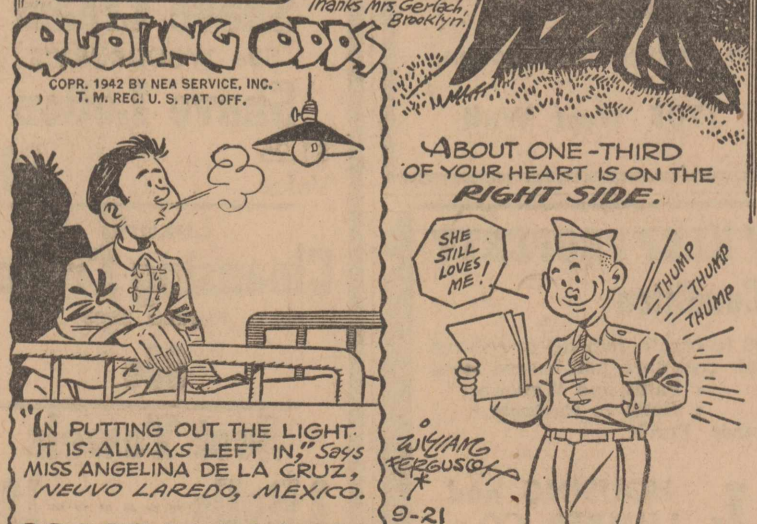
