Vividly it relates the valorous history of the Methodist Church and the part which Epworth League has played in the advancement.

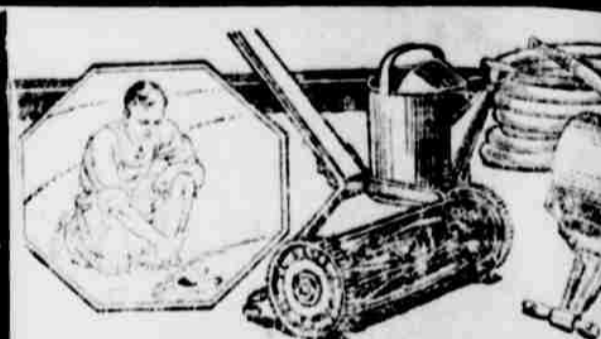
