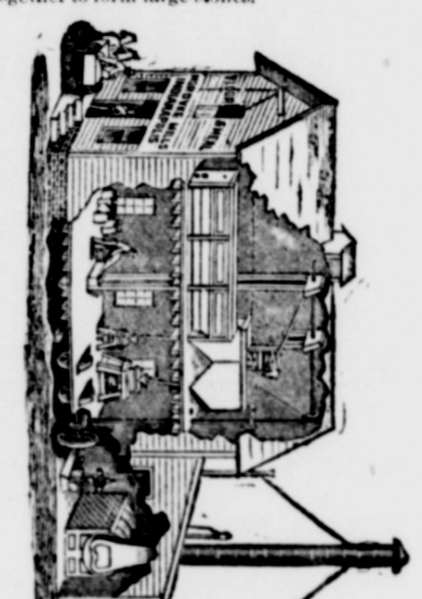
Grinding Mills, for Flour and Corn.
