RELATION OF THE SUNDAY-SCHOOL TO THE CHURCH.

REV. H. W. WILLIAMS. We are sometimes enabled to learn much about one thing by studying its relation to some other thing...

The relation of the Sunday-school to the church is certainly a very close and vital relation. It has not been very clearly defined, however.

It would seem that the first thing necessary to a clear understanding of the relation of the Sunday-school to the church is an intelligent conception of the character and design of these two institutions respectively.

The Sunday-school is, or should be, a Bible school. It is an organization composed of persons of every age, brought together for the co-operative study and teaching of the Scriptures.

Perhaps then the best and most correct statement of the relation of the Sunday-school to church would be to say that the Sunday-school is a primary department of church work designed to promote the study of the Bible, to afford moral and religious instruction and to secure the early conversion and subsequent Christian training of the children.

AIM HIGH.

THE NEED OF THE CHURCH.

A careful study of the above subject prompts me to make the following observations:

1. In most pastoral charges less than one-third of the members enrolled contribute anything to the support of the institutions of the church.

2. Less than one-tenth of them are regular attendants on prayer and class-meeting occasions.

3. Less than one-half of them are regular attendants on public worship and sacramental occasions, even on Sabbath days.

4. Many do not attend church once in a year, and never take the sacrament.

5. Of those we count stand-bys and officials in the church, one-half do not hold family worship.

To this list of negations might be added a long bill of indictment, but I forbear, as the above suggestions will answer for pastoral authority.
