The only feat in aviation which compares with Colonel Lindbergh's solo flight from New York to Paris is the return of the French airmen Dieudonne Coste and his flying mate Maurice Bellonte, who flew from Paris to New York. It is not detracting from their glory to point out that there were two of them, to relieve one another at the controls, while Lindbergh flew alone. Their feat was more hazardous, since the storm danger was greater and the wind was not in their favor.

Everyone who admires courage will indorse President Hoover's words in greeting the French flyers at the White House. Their achievement, he said, "demonstrates again the high courage of mankind.
