Wild Dogs Doing Damage on Kentucky Ranches

Lexington, Ky., Nov. 3.—Preparations are being made at the famous "Coldstream" cattle and sheep breeding farm near this city, belonging to C. B. Shaffer, Chicago millionaire, to exterminate a pack of dogs which have assumed the savagery of wolves.

The dogs have pursued several persons and recently attacked Daniel Bryant, an employee of the farm, who saved his life by opening fire on the canines.

A. H. Buehler, another employee, with Bryant, was tracking the pack when they saw Bryant and rushed at him. When he drove them off by gunfire they ran toward Buehler, who was hidden. He fired six bullets into the pack, killing four and wounding two.

The pack developed within a year from two wild dogs, and their species is unknown. Employees of the farm who visit that part of the estate where the dogs roam go heavily armed.

This month—November—is in a large measure the Harvest and thanksgiving season, next month we shall see and experience more of the holiday spirit. Agriculture is the greatest factor in any national life, a nation must be well fed if its people are to be contented and prosperous. This fact has long since been recognized as is shown by the many organizations now operating to improve the methods of production as well as to materially increase it. The nation that neglects to promote and encourage agriculture is laying stones in the path that it must travel to independence and progress.

This is time wasted for we have no less authority on that than the Apostle Paul who said: "When I was a child I spake as a child, I understood as a child, I thought as a child; but when I became a man I put away childish things." If people would search the scriptures a little more and speculate and give their opinions a little less they might arrive at many conclusions in a more authoritative way.

A number of the Senators at Washington are demanding the retirement of Secretary of Treasury, Mr. Mellon, because of his close connection with, and his powerful influence over the greater financial institutions of the United States. Senator Tom Watson's sensational charges against Military discipline of the Expeditionary forces in France is about like sending up a skyrocket on a holiday; it attracts attention only as long as visible and is thought of no more. The Senator will probably get considerable publicity out of the incident and he may succeed in establishing a small prejudice in the minds of some people, but on the whole the world will move along about the same as if Mr. Watson had not brought his grim charges to the attention of our people.






