ng safe during the holidays: If Jou are going out for the evening, turn on several lights. Turn on through the window from the outside. Turn off or unplug the lights on any indoor holiday decorations. Double-check door and minutes. If you find signs that someone has entered your home while you were away,
go to a neighbor's house immediately and call the police. If you are going out of town, do what you can to make it look a though someone is home. Put two or more interior lights on automatic
timers. Set each one on a different schedule, so that no pattern is obviights while !ou are away. Also. ask the neighbors to watch your home and to park a car in your driveway from time to time. Have the mail
