| WASHINGTON, D. C., April 22-We got our Tidelands bill out of the Judiciary Committee this week by a vote of 16 to 1 G . Texans may grow tired of hearing and reading about the Tidelands controversy. However, it is a fundamentally important is sue. Not only does it involve many millions of dollars of revjenue for the State of Texas but more importantly involves a principle of government. If the Federal Government can take our so-called Tidelands without compensation, then the Federal Government can take anything that belongs to a State or an individual without compensation. Sooner or later Congress must decide the Tidelands controversy. There is only one way in which to decide the issue and that is in behalf of the States. The issue was whether or not the Federal Power Commission can go into a State and regulate production and prices of gas in the field. It's another case of bureaucracy versus States' rights and free enterprise. The Federal Power Commission was created by Congress and given the power to go into a State and fix the price of gas at the well. Federal bureaus and Federal administrators are always attempting to exceed the authority given them through the laws which Congress has passed. One of our big problems in government is to keep government from becoming more powerful than the people to whom it belongs-to keep government from abusing powers delegated to it.
