prepared for the garden is the best investment a dry farmer can have. This land should be tilled a whole year in advance with a view of storing and con serving the moisture, and if possible, fertilized. A bunch of 50 chickens will make enough fer tilizer for two acres. This fer-

With a two acre den handled on these lines three hours every five days (if it is dry) will be the most profit able investment one can have Try it once and see.
