between Callan's scalp pasture, a tickfree pasture, and the Rasmussen ranch, a ticky pasture. The gate had
repeatedly been left open and Callan had spent much time in trying to get the pasture rid of ticks.
Callan and his son, Russell Callan, vere going home when they found the gate open again. They closed the gate

between dusk and dark. Callan testified he asked Billings if he left the gate open. Billings said he did. A
