## Packers' Profits

 Are RegulatedThe public should understand that the profits of the packers have been imited by the Food Administration since November 1, 1917. For this pur pose, the business of Swift \& Company is now divided into three classes

Class 1 includes such products as beef. pork, mutton, oleomargarine and
others that are essentially animal products. Profits are limited to 9
per cent of the capital employed in per cent of tha capital employed plus and borrowed money), or not each dollar of sales.
Class 2 includes the soap, glue, more or, less associated with the
meat business. Many of these de. meat business. Many of these de-
partments are in competition with outside businesses whose profit
are not limited. Profits in this clas are restricted to 15 per cento of th Class 3
 foreign countries. Profits in thin
class are not limite.

Total profits for all departments together in 1918 will probably be between three and four per cent on an increased volume of sales.

The restrictions absolutely guar ive stock prices and wholesale mea prices, because the packer's profit can not possibly average more than a fraction of a cent per pound of product. Since the pronts on meat (Class are running only about 2 cents on each dollar of sales, we have to depend on the pronts from soap, giue, fertilizer (Class 2, also limited) and other departments, (Class 3) to obtain reasonabie earnings on capital.
