Toy Drive Brings Cheer

More than 150 local children will have a happier Christmas this year thanks to the efforts of Jim and Mona Boles and the staff at KPOS Radio.

The annual KPOS Toys Drive has resulted in the donation of more toys than ever before through the generosity of lots of people.

The largest single contribution came as a surprise when two men pulled up to the radio station office in downtown Post last week and unloaded two Ford Bronco pick-up trucks loaded full of new toys.

"And these toys weren't cheapos," Boles comments, "they were in the \$15 to \$20 or more bracket...and I guess there must be at least \$3,000 worth of toys those two donated."

Boles said the men wished to remain unidentified, but did say they were working in the oil field here and "Garza County has been real good to us and we just wanted to return some of the good back to the folks here," Boles quotes the contributors.

"Their donation certainly is appreciated," Boles adds, but it does not take away from the hundreds of other contributors whose gifts are just as important."

Earlier in the month Boles was concerned that enough toys could be collected to satisfy the demand, mainly because so many more needy children were identified this year.

"It makes all the work and everything worth it when you see the bright smiles on the faces of those children getting the gifts.

All of us, right now, know of people, either family or friends or acquaintances, who will not have a happy holiday season or a Merry Christmas.

Those folks are torn apart by a variety of adverse circumstances...death in the family, the first Christmas without a loved one, divorce, alcoholism, physical abuse of children or spouses, financial difficulties, hospitalization, old-age, loneliness and so many other problems we don't have space to print them all.

You'll see these type folks on your television screen during this time, with reminders that there are charitable minded souls giving up their time and money to

help those less fortunate ones.

I am personally reminded at this time of year of the unhappiness of little children who will not enjoy the standard Christmas celebration.

And I'm not just talking about children in homes of the poor.

Not having enough money is a universal problem touching millions of homes... that material problem is nothing compared to the emotional abuse children we know will suffer next week.

They will wake up with expectations of joy on Christmas Eve, knowing way back in their minds that the reality of alcoholism will shatter the dream before the day is out...or the next day.

One or more of adults in these families will start the day with great intentions... but the sobering fact is that before bedtime Christmas Eve, or during Christmas Day the alcoholic will destroy the beauty of the family gathering.

WHEAT DEFICIENCY announced as \$1.00 per bushel, based on the difference between the \$4.38 payment rate has been target price and the \$3.38

farm price. Checks have been mailed to eligible producers.

Cotton Production

Remember to turn in your cotton production after all your cotton including green bolls and remnants have been ginned. Extra production cards are available here at the office.

Cotton Loans

Loans are available on 1984 production based on 55.20 cents per pound for SLM 1-16 and 3.5 to 4.9 micronaire. Seed cotton loans are also available for cotton stored in modules. The interest rate for loans

disbursed in December is 10.125 percent.

1985 Program

Signup for the 1985 commodity programs continues until March 1, 1985. Advance deficiency and diversion payments are authorized when you request them and all necessary signatures are obtained. Contracts to participate may be withdrawn until March 1, 1985. After March 1, the contract becomes binding and liquidated damages will be assessed for non compliance.
