

World premier of original play opens at Garza Theatre Thursday

Another first at the Garza Theatre will be recorded May 23 when the world premier showing of "The Home Place," an original play by Plainview's Bettye Hammer Givens, opens for four performances through Sunday, May 26.

The sentimental West Texas comedy centers around a family dealing with the loss of their mother, the division of the estate, unresolved conflicts from the past and the comic misunderstandings that result.

Starring in the hilarious situation comedy are Garza Theatre veterans Linda Ellis, Charles Somerville, Ruth Longtin and Randy Sutherland. Appearing for the first time here will be Elise Higgins and Rafe Foreman.

This is also the first time at the Garza Theatre for a guest director to take charge with veteran actress and stage manager Christy Morris leading the action. Designing the set is technical director Troy Timms.

The production is made possible by a "creative, writing and design award" by Giles and Nelda Dalby in honor of Guy and El-Dess Floyd.

Bettye Hammer Givens has a long list of literary credits, including an invitation to attend the First Literary Glasnost Tour of Soviet Russia in June 1989, joining American and Soviet poets in public readings in Moscow, Kiev and Leningrad.

She is also credited with setting poems to music and translated into Italian.

Her plays include "Running Water Musical," "Giants of the Great Plateau," "The Home Place," and a 1987 screenplay, "Signed, Sealed and Delivered."

Her professional experience includes a two years on the faculty of Wayland Baptist University, Writing Program Faculty, Summer in France Writing Workshop, Paris American Academy in Paris, France and Carrizo Lodge Art School Writing Workshop as well as Studio 111 Writing Workshop in Ruidoso, NM.

Givens has been a contributing author for MacGuffin Magazine, Historical Literary Quarterly, Paris Atlantic, Paris Magazine, The Christian Science Monitor and short stories.

She has also appeared on KTXT Channel 5's host of "The Conversation Club" in Lubbock.

Givens is a member of the National Arts Club, Associated Writing Programs, Association of Creative Writing Teachers and Dramatist Guild.

Performances begin promptly at 7:45 Thursday, Friday and Saturday evenings and at 2 p.m. Sunday. Tickets are \$7 for adults and \$3 for students six to 12 years old.

Sales tax rebate continues impressive gains for Post

The City of Post received a \$19,776.28 check from the state comptroller, representing a 35.99 percent increase over the same period last year and a 23.87 percent increase for the year.

Last year's check at this time was \$14,542.75.

The year to date total of \$79,126.22 is an increase over the same period last year of \$63,879.66.

This month's check included taxes collected on March sales and reported in April by businesses filing monthly returns and also includes taxes reported by those filing quarterly returns for sales made in January, February and March.

Through the first five months of 1991, the state has rebated a total of \$740.9 million to city and county governments for a 10.6 percent increase over the same period last year.

Possession of controlled substance leads arrests

Garza County Sheriff's deputies arrested a 32 year old man May 15, charging him with possession of a controlled substance. He posted a \$5,000 bail and was released pending trial in District Court.

May 18 deputies arrested a 27 year old man, charging him with a second DWI offense. He posted a \$2,500 bond and is awaiting trial in county court. The man was arrested two miles north of Post on U.S. Hwy 84.

A 29 year old man was arrested by Texas DPS officers May 18, charged in county court for DWI. He posted a \$1,500 bond and was released pending trial.

A simple assault charge was filed May 19 on a 35 year old man, arrested by deputies here. The case is in the Justice of the Peace Precinct One court. The man paid a \$217.50 fine and served time in the jail on the offense.

A 35 year old woman paid a \$118 fine on a theft under \$20 charge. The case was filed in municipal court.

Post ISD trustees begin plans for central air and heat for campus buildings

After a lengthy discussion of the proposed installation of central air conditioning and heating for all three Post ISD campus buildings, trustees authorized the advertising of bids for the project, which will include a variety of emergency repairs as well as other improvements.

Funding for the project will come from ISD reserves.

Among the other maintenance items to be bid are painting, installation of handicapped facilities at both gymnasiums, auditorium sound system improvements, upgrading of the high school science lab, installation of vinyl flooring at the middle school and addition of six new classrooms at the elementary school.

Bill Stracener, architect and engineer, reported that a serious crack in the walls of the middle school gym have been discovered. Although not serious enough to close the facility, Stracener told trustees that water leaking around the window frames has created a structural problem which must be corrected soon.

The air conditioning and heating project will use roof mounted systems at the high school, middle school and elementary school.

Superintendent Bill Shiver told board members that the state is aiming to force all ISDs to tax at the rate of \$1.50 per \$100 and to set standard salaries for teachers state wide. The current tax rate for Post ISD is \$.93, and under the projected losses of state funding recently enacted by the Texas Legislature, the tax rate will be increased approximately 45 percent to maintain current levels.

"We plan to study all programs at all campuses," Shiver emphasized, "and be prepared to cut and make tough decisions if the taxpayers decide to call for a tax rollback."

Shiver also pointed out that decision

making in Austin seems to be in a turmoil at the Texas Education Agency. "We're still really not sure how this new funding plan is going to be handled, and I recommend we proceed with our normal budgeting process and get on with the important task of educating our children."

Following administering of the oath of office by Kay Hays to newly elected trustees Mark Kirkpatrick, Dan Hodges, Rex Cash, Barbara Hardin and Gary Workman, the board elected Hodges to serve as president, Hardin as vice president and Ronnie Gradine as secretary.

Upon Shiver's recommendation, the board approved a policy of maintaining a minimum of 90 days operating revenue in a reserve fund balance, which is the same level recommended by the state.

The contract with the Regional Media Services was approved.

Terms of a contract with Stracener, which is being prepared by the ISD's attorneys, was also approved. The contract sets a 6.25 percent payment to Stracener on construction costs of projects approved by the board.

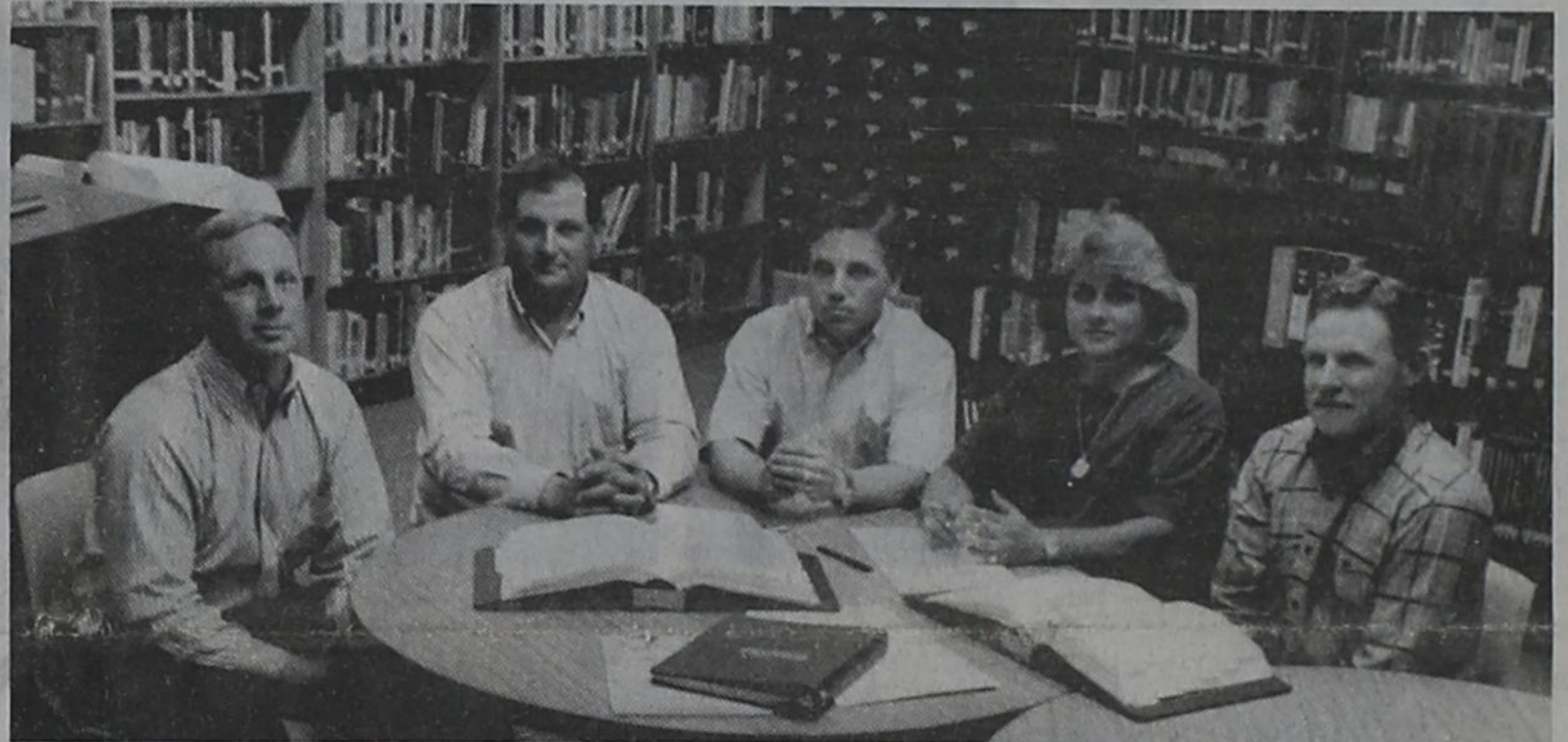
Shiver was appointed to serve on the Regional Advisory Committee of the Education Service Center.

Certificates of deposit were approved for renewal ranging in rates from 5.05 percent to 5.12 percent for 30 days totaling \$4,303,027.

Budget change requests were also approved along with career ladder supplements.

A statistical progress report on delinquent tax collections was accepted, and trustees approved a five percent increase in salaries, reflecting the 5.3 percent Consumer Price Index increase for the past 12 months.

Attending the meeting were trustees Hodges, Hardin, Workman, Cash, Kirkpatrick, Gradine and Pru Basquez.

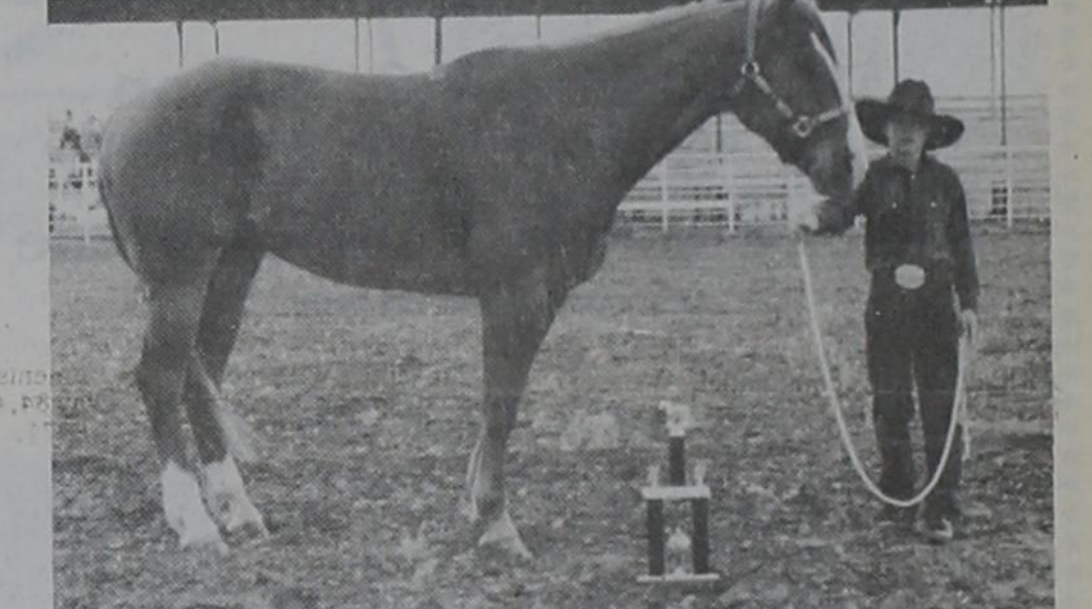

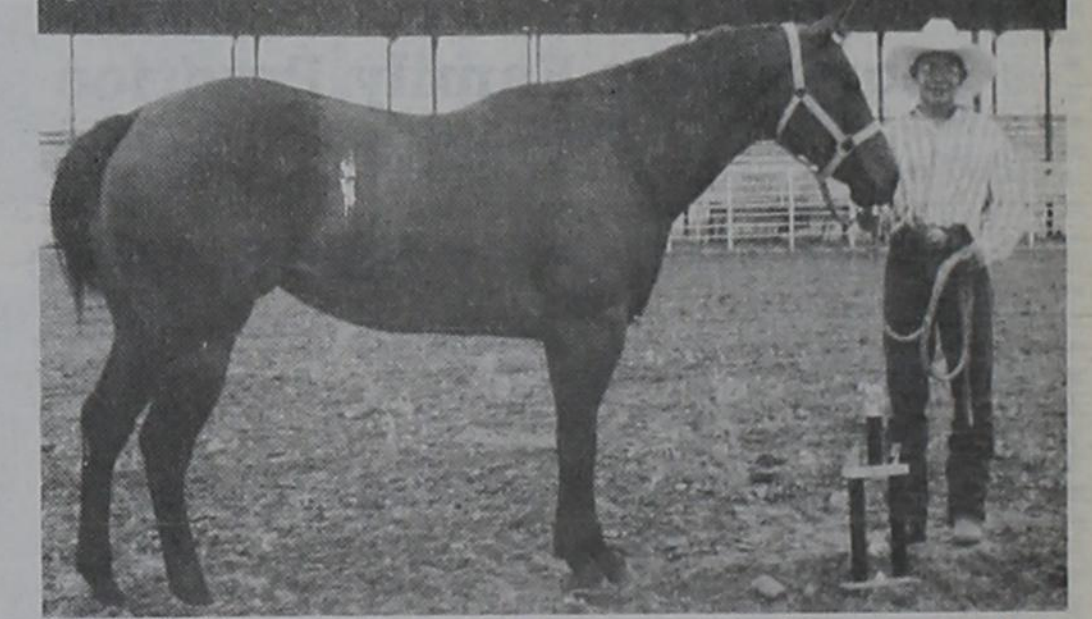

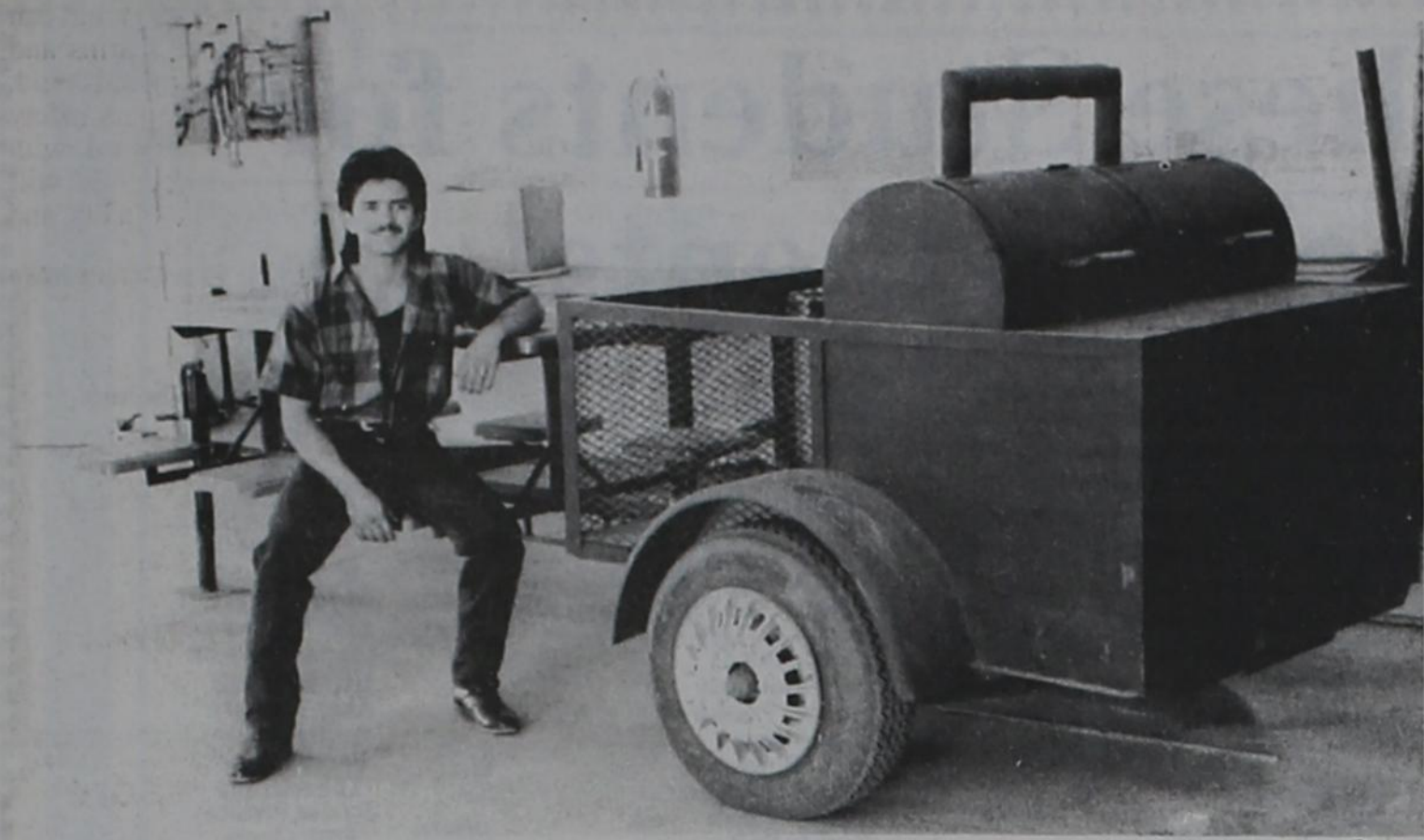
