Commissioners support White River in permit extension application

Garza County Judge Giles Dalby and members of the Commissioners' Court, plan to attend a special Texas Water Commission hearing in Austin January 15, 1992 to express support for the White River Municipal Water District's application to extend the permit to build the Post dam and reservoir.

"We want to do everything we can to ensure that this extension request is approved," Dalby explained. He also added that there is no reason to expect any problems with the application, "but we certainly don't want to take any chances."

Commissioners approved a resolution supporting White River's application. Dalby added that State Senator John Montford and State Representative David Counts also are supporting the application.

When the permit is approved, Dalby suggested that the commissioners court begin discussions with White River MWD board of directors to develop ways the county could help begin construction of the dam.

One idea presented by Dalby was the development of a county-wide water or recreational district, with taxing authority, which would be presented to the voters for approval.

"The building of the dam and reservoir will be very expensive," Dalby added, "and I think the taxpayers should know this and be given the opportunity to decide the future development of the lake."

In other action, commissioners took no action on a request from the district court to provide a bailiff. Commissioner Herb Walls questioned the need, "considering the Sheriff has six deputies, surely one of them could be assigned on court days to handle this."

Dalby explained that there are times when deputies are just not available, especially now that the grand jury is meeting every other month. After a brief discussion, Dalby said he would provide more information on the part time position and place the item on the agenda for next month.

Dalby reported that the Garza County Tax Appraisal District has completed its fiscal year with more than \$25,000 in savings. The extra money saved in expenses will be rebated to participating government units based on the volume of collections from each unit.

Board members are Jack Alexander, Dalby, Royce Hart, Jack Lott and V.C. Wheeler.

Dalby presented a recent letter from the Texas Health Department which informed the court that the illegal dumping problem in Precinct One has been corrected and the item is closed. Commissioners then entered into a discussion

about the impending problems associated with the closing of the Post landfill.

The possibility of opening a county landfill was aired, as well as other options for keeping garbage off the county roads.

Commissioners entered into executive session at the request of county employee Scott Zapert.

Attending the meeting were Dalby, commissioners Walls, John Valdez, Albert Stone and Sammy Ellis and clerk Sonny Gossett.

This ANN That

Does a second job pay off?

Making ends meet is getting harder, it seems. That's why so many families depend on income from a second or even a third job. Taking another job to make ends meet is a realistic solution for many people. But it is also important to recognize that every job has a "cost of earning" factor -- what it actually costs the worker to earn a living. A close look at employment-related income and expenses can give a realistic view of what to expect.

On the income side, consider how many hours and days a week you will work and what your total income will be. Compare your present expenses for fringe benefits such as insurance and pension plans and how much is being contributed toward Social Security. What will be the costs and advantages of these benefits with the new job? Some people, particularly those who have not had any health insurance coverage, find a second job that offers insurance benefits worthwhile even if the wages are relatively low. That's because the cost of health care would be even greater.

Work-related expenses to consider include special work clothes or uniforms that must be purchased; dues, fees and licenses; job-related publications; business meetings and conferences; and tools, equipment and supplies.

If an additional vehicle must be purchased to get to work, figure in the extra costs of transportation (work-related share of vehicle purchase cost, car loan, licenses, taxes, fees, insurance, gas, oil, maintenance, parking and tolls). If other forms of transportation are required, calculate those costs.

If a family member who has stayed at home returns to the job environment, there may be extra

family expenses that are incurred that will reduce the amount of total family income available. Child care, hired household help, additional laundry/dry cleaning, more family meals out, changes in home food preparation, and household repair/maintenance needs may all contribute to increased family expenses.

Child care is a major expense for families needing such care. The average weekly child care cost for families paying for such services was \$49 in 1987 (latest data). When total income is less than \$1250 per month, families spend almost 21 percent on child care services.

The worker may also encounter added expenses for personal care, clothing, and work place related situations such as coffee breaks, gifts and parties.

Another cost of employment relates to the tax angle. Additional earnings can raise the tax bill because more income may push the earners into a different tax bracket. Some work-related expenses may be deductible as itemized expenses, but with a larger adjusted gross income, they may not qualify for deduction within those limits.

Clearly, having a job may have more than just economic meaning for the worker and for the family. New jobs always hold special personal meaning. Several non-economic issues should also be discussed with other household members, such as sharing of the household workload, child care responsibilities, sharing of farm production activities for farm families, seasonal variation in workloads, and time commitments for a volunteer, religion-related, school activities, and/or social organizations.

DPS warns that drunk driving is nations most serious health and safety problem

FACT: Drunk driving continues to be one of the nations most serious health and safety problems. However, Major V.J. Cawthon, Regional Commander of the Texas Department of Public Safety says that Federal, State, Local, and private efforts to reduce the incidents of drinking and driving are having an impact.

Major Cawthon says with the approach of New Year's Eve that this trend can continue if each of us will do our part in pre-planning our New Year's Eve celebration.

It is recommended that if your going to host a party, that soft drinks be available for your guest so they will have a choice.

Introduce people to one another, a good host is not just a bartender. Don't rush refills, don't double up because it's not generous, it's rude.

Attempt to have a meal or snacks available throughout the evening and, above all, if someone drinks too much at your house, you are responsible. Provide lodging or get them a safe ride home.

If your plans include traveling this New Year's Eve, then make plans that only allow a totally sober driver to be behind the wheel.

It's a good idea to check with your local media outlets to see if any organizations will be providing ride home programs.

For those who think that it will never happen to them, the Department of Public Safety, along with other local law enforcement agencies, will have stepped up patrols and DWI enforcement over the New Year's Eve holiday.

Major Cawthon went on to say that one of the best defenses against a drunk driver is to fasten your safety belt, but it's only effective if the driver and all occupants take time to do so.

Let's all work toward making this the safest New Year's Holiday ever.

Rural Scholar Recognition Program to help fill vacancies

Rural Texas communities, challenged by the need to fill vacancies in all health care professions, can now take advantage of a unique state-supported program, the Outstanding Rural Scholar Recognition Program administered by the Center for Rural Health Initiatives. The Center is accepting applications until February 14, 1992, for the academic year beginning September, 1992.

Under the program an organization in a rural community acts as a sponsor to a student in a health care field. The sponsor agrees to contribute financial support for the student's educational and living costs. In turn, the student agrees that he or she will work for the sponsor as a health care professional upon graduation.

Students who are selected as an Outstanding Rural Scholar based on academic records and recommendations are also eligible for loans under the Outstanding Rural Scholar Recognition Program. State funds are available through this program to match the rural sponsor's contribution. For each year that the student works for the sponsoring community organization after graduation, one year's principal and interest on the loan is forgiven.

There are now 10 rural Texas communities sponsoring students in the program in such health care fields as medicine, nursing, occupational therapy and physical therapy.

Many rural Texas communities already subsidize educational expenses for local students pursuing a health career. The Outstanding Rural Scholar Recognition Program can help a community ensure a well-trained and committed health care work force for the future.

DPS releases November report

Capt L.A. Reinhart, District Supervisor of the Lubbock Highway Patrol District comprising of 21 counties said, "For the month of November, our trooper investigated two fatal accidents, 49 personal injury accidents, and 60 personal property damage accidents. There were two persons killed and 72 persons injured in these acci-

dents." Sgt Glenn Fant of Crosbyton stated, "In Garza county, our troopers investigated one personal injury accident and two property damage accidents in the month of November. One person was injured in these accidents."

According to Lubbock-based Plains Cotton Growers (PCG) new weather delays will likely prevent producers from getting the remainder of the 1991 crop to the gin before Christmas.

Harvesting activities could have been concluded across the area before Christmas with a few more days of good weather. Unfortunately, wet weather set in late Wednesday and is not expected to move out of the area before Sunday.

Reports from across the High Plains show area cotton to be approximately 85-percent out of the field. Many of the area's smaller gins are already winding down their operations while larger gins expect to remain active for several more weeks.

As 1991 comes to a close High Plains producers are closely monitoring the development of two major items: the Disaster Bill and the final deficiency payment. Early projections placed the final deficiency payment somewhere between 8 and 10 cents. PCG now expects the final deficiency payment to total between 9 and 9.5 cents per pound.

Producers who received the 4 cent advance payment can probably expect to receive a final payment in the neighborhood of five cents. Calculation of the deficiency payment rate is based on a formula that calculates the weighted average farm price of all U.S. cotton with respect to total marketings for the year. This figure is then subtracted from the 72.9 cent target price to derive the final payment rate.

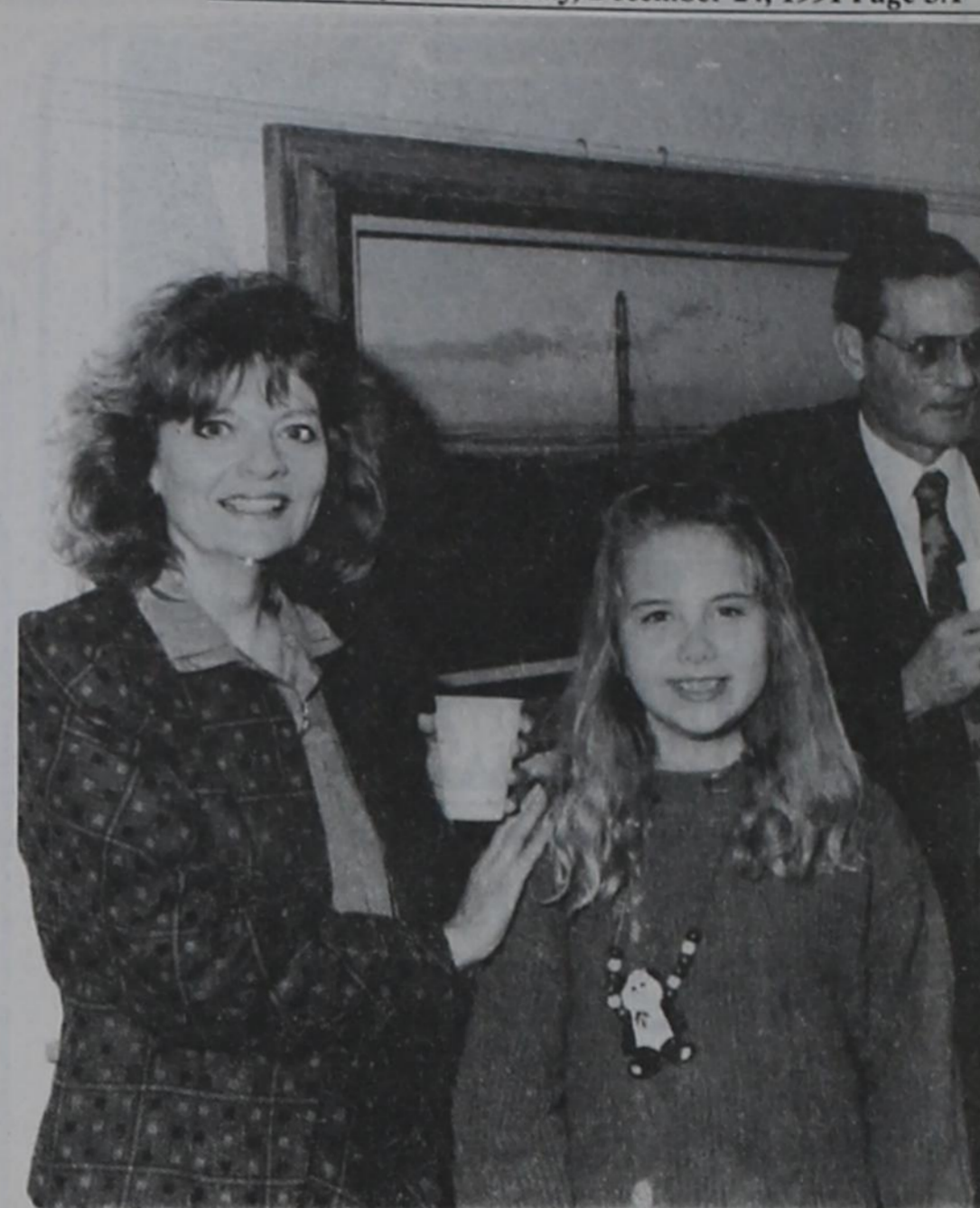
Producers continue to take advantage of the Loan Deficiency Payment (LDP) program, often referred to as the producer option payment, in exchange for agreeing not to put that cotton in the government loan program.

Thursday's announcement of a 44.07 cent Adjusted World Price (AWP) continues the recent trend of the Secretary of Agriculture using his discretionary authority to keep U.S. cotton competitive in the world market. It also maintains the LDP payment rate of 6.7 cents per pound.

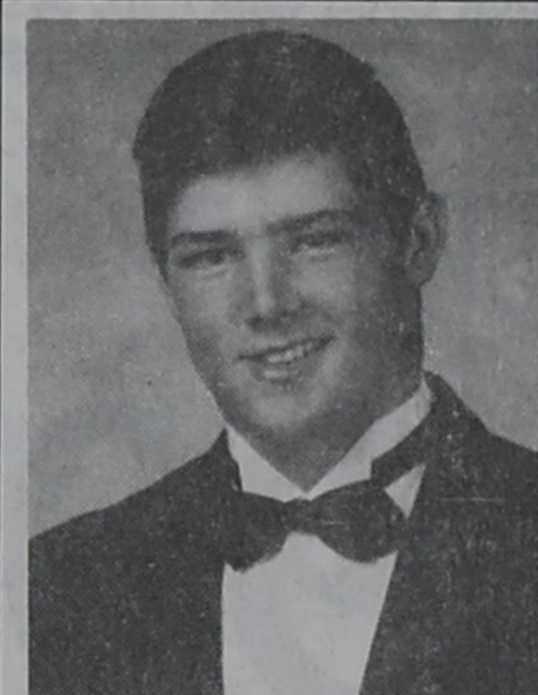
Development of regulations for the recently approved disaster bill remains a top priority. PCG is continually stressing the importance of getting these regulations approved as quickly as possible.

"High Plains producers know that any delay is going to weigh heavily on what they are able to do for next year's crop," notes Donald Johnson, PCG Executive Vice President. "Accordingly, PCG is doing everything possible to encourage the rapid development of the necessary regulations so that producers can begin receiving this aid as quickly as possible."

USDA officially announced the Upland Cotton Acreage Reduction Program (ARP) for 1992 earlier this week. The 1992 ARP will be 10 percent; identical to the preliminary ARP announcement made November 1.

Program to help low income Texans buy a home

Gov. Ann W. Richards announced today that the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs (TDHCA) will make \$36 million in mortgage financing available to qualified low income Texans for the purchase of a home.

Under the newly created Program 44, families and individuals who have not owned a home in three years may buy a home at a 7.5 percent fixed interest rate on a 30-year FHA or VA mortgage.

"The dream of owning a home for many the Texans who take advantage of this program will no longer just be a dream," said Richards. "The low interest rate available should help many people turn that dream into a reality."

In an effort to increase the home-ownership eligibility of very low income Texans, TDHCA is starting a down-payment assistance program. Through this program, the agency hopes to assist those Texans who don't have the equity to make a down-payment. The loans are available at zero percent interest and do not have to be paid back until the borrower sells the home.

The down-payment assistance program will be available to qualified families at 80 percent or below of the area median income. The program is to be used in conjunction with Program 44 and all existing bond programs.

Program 44 is part of TDHCA's Single-Family Bond Program which aims to serve families that earn sufficient income to make monthly mortgage payments but

have difficulty qualifying for a loan at the market interest rate.

The Single-Family Bond Program is funded through the sale of tax-exempt mortgage revenue bonds. The proceeds from the sale of the bonds are allocated to numerous mortgage lenders across Texas, who then finance below-market rate loans to qualifying individuals and families.

In order to qualify for the program, the income of families of three or more must exceed 115 percent of the applicable median family income and the income of families of two or fewer must not exceed 100 percent of the applicable median family income. The average median family income for the state of Texas is \$35,600. However, qualifying income levels for the program vary according

to geographic location throughout the state.

The 72nd Legislature created TDHCA by merging the former Texas Housing Agency and the former Texas Department of Community Affairs. The Community Development Block Grant was also transferred from the Texas Department of Commerce to TDHCA. With the variety of complementary programs now under its management, TDHCA is committed to assisting the citizens of Texas, efficiently and effectively.

TEX MEX CRANBERRY SAUCE

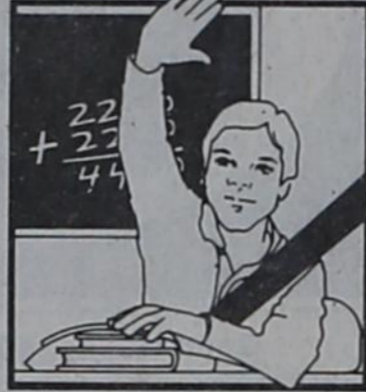
- 1 cup water

Rural health care takes another step forward

Congressman Charles Stenholm (D-TX) said rural health care took a step forward on Tuesday when the House of Representatives approved the Health Professions Training Reauthorization.

The bill extends for three years, the authorization of health professions and nursing education programs under the Public Health

Service Act. The bill authorizes \$262.6 million in FY 1992 for health professions and nursing education programs.

Included in the overall bill is reauthorization for the Area Health Education Centers (AHEC) program. The AHEC program, which will receive \$24 million during FY 1992, was developed twenty years ago as a new type of regional education and training center which links university health science centers with medically underserved communities in order to improve access to health care services. The program encompasses as wide range of allied health services including physical therapy, occupational therapy, and laboratory technology, plus dentistry, mental health, pharmacy, social work and nursing.

"By getting health professionals into underserved areas, we are improving the quality of life for people in less populated areas," said

Stenholm. "Every person in this country should be able to get quality health care in their home community."

Stenholm, who was actively involved in drafting the AHEC provisions of the bill, explained that the AHEC program includes a variety of components designed to improve access in rural areas. Some examples are rotations of medical and nursing students, off-campus degrees for all types of health care personnel, continuing education, and technical assistance of professional support services to practitioners in underserved communities. The program also encouraged an increase in the number of minority citizens who pursue health careers through junior and senior high school recruiting efforts, and library and information services.

Stenholm, who is co-chairman of the Rural Health Care Coalition, said it is estimated that 75 percent of AHEC activities occur in rural communities, with the other 25 percent occurring in underserved urban areas.

Winter season is approaching states Texas DPS

The Texas Department of Public Safety wants to remind motorists that the winter season is fast approaching and it is once again time to repair our vehicle and especially the driver for one of the most dangerous times ahead, winter driving.

Major V.J. Cawthon, Regional Commander for the Texas Department of Public Safety in Lubbock, said, "Winter driving can be very dangerous. Drivers are faced with many more dangers than they usually have during the rest of the year, such as driving on icy or snow packed highways, freezing temperatures, freezing rain, sleet, all creating dangerous conditions for the driver."

The most important safety tip for driving in the winter time when the streets are slick is to remember to slow down. Remember, it can easily take from two to three times longer to stop compared to when the roads are dry.

When temperatures drop below the freezing point, drivers must remember to scrape the frost and ice from all windows before driving, to keep your headlights clean of mud and snow, and above all keep plenty of windshield washer anti-freeze mixture in the window washers for those unexpected "splashes" from other cars.

Major Cawthon also stated that when driving during adverse weather conditions to allow plenty of time and to start your trip a little early because there is no way to make up time on the streets and highways. If you are driving a four-wheel drive vehicle, remember you may be able to start off better and the steering may seem a little better, but it takes just as long to stop a four-wheel drive as it takes to stop a two-wheel drive.

By using a little more caution and more defensive driving, you can make winter driving alot safer.
