Vegetables Spark Lazy Appetites With Their Appeal

DON'T try to stuff your family with hearty meals all of the time! Right now with warm weather slowly making itself felt they're apt to show a distinct lack of interest in meals.
 Vegetable combinations make excellent main dishes if you add a protein food such as eggs or cheese to them. Besides, it's an excellent way to keep the food budget trim.
 Green peppers stuffed with corn mixture are a pretty as well as nourishing and interesting vegetable dish. You'll want to keep this recipe on file for the next several months:

Corn-Pepper Bake

(Serves 6)
 6 large green peppers
 4 slices bacon
 1 egg
 1 tablespoon butter
 2 tablespoons finely diced onion
 2 tablespoons flour
 1 teaspoon sugar (optional)
 1½ teaspoons salt
 1½ cups milk, scalded
 2 cups cooked corn
 ½ cup soft bread crumbs
 Wash peppers, cut a slice from the side of each and remove seeds and fibrous parts. Cover with boiling water and simmer 5 minutes. Meanwhile cook bacon, drain and dice. Beat egg slightly. Melt butter, add onion and cook until tender. Add flour, sugar, seasoning and blend. Add milk and corn.



Bacon and corn go into a custard-like mixture as a stuffing for parboiled green peppers to make a satisfying and colorful main dish for lunch or supper. Cheese Sauce adds nourishment to the vegetables.

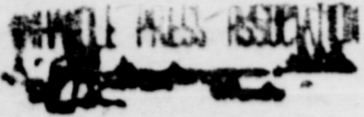

Jury Duty Is Obligation Of All Citizens

One of these days—perhaps soon—you may get a notice telling you to report for jury duty—and to "fail not." In serving, you share one of the most solemn duties known to our democracy.

Some people try to get out of jury service. It may be inconvenient or unpleasant. Yet, when you are put on a jury you should think of this as a chance to help make good one of the promises of our Constitution—trial by jury. Say the following to yourself:

"My forefathers wrested my right to serve as a juror from tyrants.

"Under our law no one's life, liberty, or property can be taken without due process of law.

"Trial by jury is our basic right. All who seek their day in court should have a fair hearing. They will get it from me.

"I will not ask to be excused from jury service except in an emergency.

To Warn Of Twisters

Texas will meet the 1956 tornado season with one of the world's most complete storm warning systems, and with a well-oiled disaster relief organization.

Radar storm warning sets in operation in 14 of the state's 29 first-order weather bureaus. All state highway patrolmen have been carefully schooled in the wily ways of the weather and are keeping a sharp eye on the sky as they patrol the state.

A patrolman is credited with sounding the first warning of the awesome San Angelo storm of 1953.

Texas "local severe weather warning system," the first established anywhere in the world, is made up of sets operating around the clock in Amarillo, Wichita Falls, Fort Worth, Midland, Lubbock, Abilene, San Angelo, Waco, Austin, Port Arthur, Galveston, Houston, Corpus Christi, Victoria, San Antonio, and Brownsville.

Only four of the state's first-order weather bureau—El Paso, Laredo, Del Rio, and Dallas, are without warning networks.

All stations are connected by teletype and radio. Any station is able to instantly appraise all other stations of a tornado traveling in their direction. When such a warning is given, the weather bureau in the storm's line of approach immediately notifies all communities in the area.

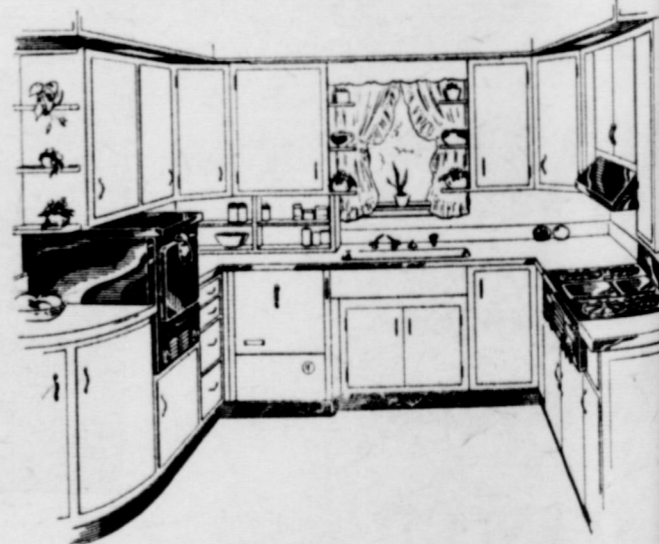

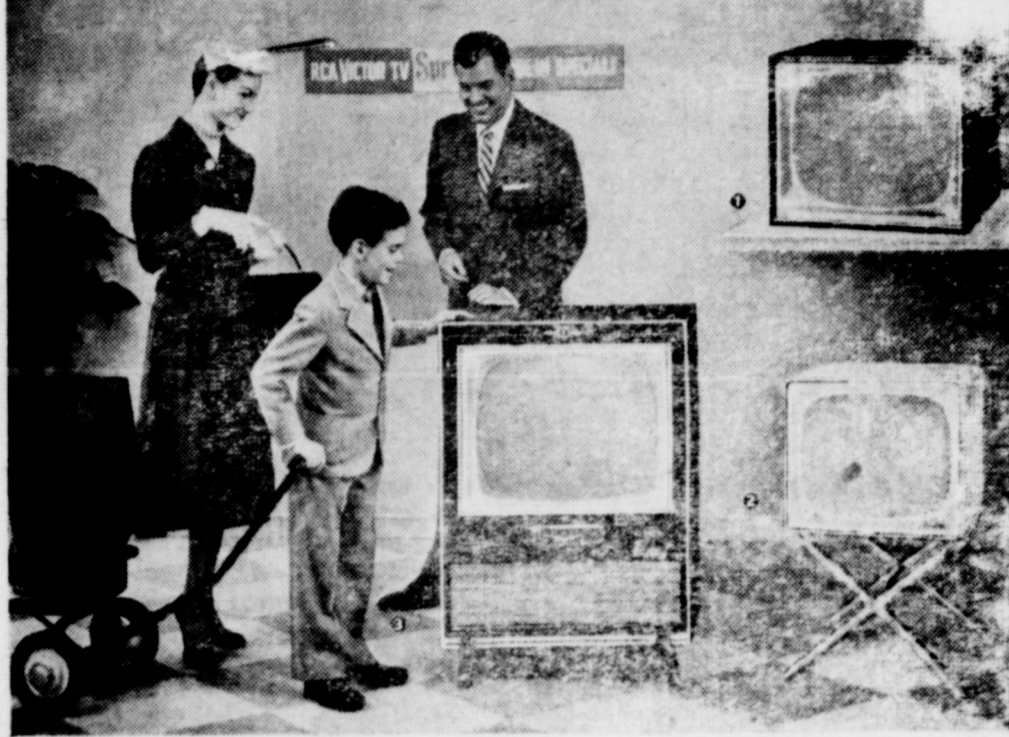
