PLAN TO RETIRE?

If you intend to retire this month and file a claim at the Social Security District Office for retirement benefits, you should bring the W-2 which you received from your employer, or a copy of your 1956 income tax return, according to John G. Hutton, manager of that office. The W-2 can be used to verify your 1956 earnings if you worked for someone else. The income tax return plus a carefully completed schedule C, Profit or Loss from Business, is essential if you are in business for yourself in 1956. Cancelled check or other evidence of payment of the Social Security tax should also be available if you were self-employed in 1956.

Mr. Hutton says that his office is having an exceptionally high intake of claims since the first of the year, and some delays will be unavoidable. However if claimants will come prepared with the proof of earnings described above, this record volume of work can be processed more rapidly.

Mr. Hutton points out that the social security amendments of 1956 which brought new groups under the program, reduced the retirement age for women, and provided benefits for the severely disabled worker age 50 to 65, are responsible for the sharp increase in the work in his office.

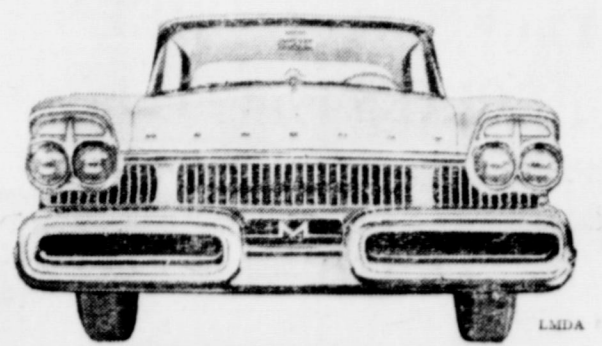

New S. S. Ruling Given
 Monthly insurance payments can now be paid to the handicapped son or daughter of a retired or a deceased worker, according to John G. Hutton, District Manager of the Lubbock office of the Social Security Administration.
 "This is the first year that payments can be made to a dependent child who is incapable of self-support due to a physical or mental disability."
 "Payments can begin for January of this year to a person of any age who was disabled before he reached age 18," Mr. Hutton says. Such payments are made on the social security account of a parent of the disabled person. The parent must be an insured worker who has retired or died.
 "Before this new provision went into effect, no family insurance could be paid for a child after he became 18 years of age. Now there is no age limit for a disabled child," he added.
 Applications for these payments should be filed with the Social Security Administration, 2878-34th Street, Lubbock, Texas.

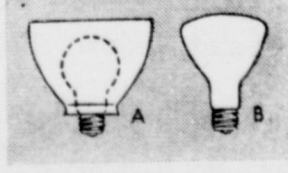
Make seeing and studying easier!

with proper light at the study table

School age youngsters need plenty of good light to prevent eye fatigue and to aid concentration. You'll be giving your children real help with their homework when you make sure they have good study lighting.

In most instances, a good table lamp with a 150-watt bulb will provide ample light. The lamp should be properly shaded to conceal the light source from the eyes and should be tall enough to spread light evenly over the work area.

Check home study lighting now. Be sure your youngsters have plenty of good light to make seeing and studying easier.



LOOK UNDER THE SHADE! To soften the light and prevent glare, a study lamp should be equipped with a diffusing bowl (A), or a 150-watt white indirect bulb (B), which has its own built-in diffuser. For three-way lamps use a 50-100-150 watt or 30-200-230 watt three-way bulb.

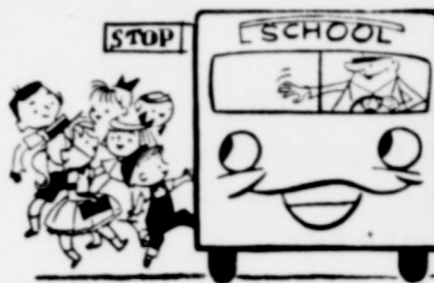
