V. A. Quiz

Q— I'm a World War Two veteran and I understand that a new law now gives me until July 25, 1960, to get a GI loan. Has the deadline also been extended for direct VA loan?

A— Yes. The direct loan program, which was to have ended June 30, 1958, also was extended to July 25, 1960.

Q— I lost the discharge I received when I came out of service. Where do I get another and is there any charge for the replacement?

A— To replace a lost discharge, write to the Personnel Records Center of the Armed Forces, 9700 Page Boulevard, St. Louis, Missouri. Give your service number and include your branch of service. There is no charge for replacement.

Q— I'm a Korea veteran, figuring on starting school this fall under the GI Bill. Is it too early to apply now?

A— It is not too early to apply. Many schools are crowded, so early application gives you a better chance of gaining admittance to the school of your choice.

Q— I'm a veteran with a service-connected disability rated 50 percent, and with two dependents, my wife and our three-months old son. However, I have only recently notified VA of my new dependent. Will the additional compensation to which I am entitled be made retroactive to the child's birth?

A— No. The increase will be effective only from the date VA receives your application.



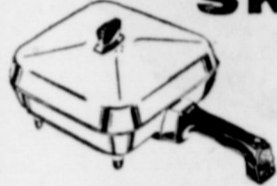

owned a magic novelty store. At the same time while attending college, McReynolds held three different part time jobs.

Since that time he has been an oil field scout, and in February he started a newspaper called the Andrews Reporter. He is active in civic projects and is a member of the Chamber of Commerce, the Andrews Jaycees, Lions Club, Loyal Order of Moose, Woodman of the World Society, and Fraternal Order of Eagles.

McReynolds and his wife, Patricia, have three sons, Bobby, 7, Charles, Jr., 4, and John, 2 months and a daughter, Rebekah Ann, 2.

In announcing his candidacy, McReynolds said — "I am the first to announce for this office standing against the possible passage of a state sales tax. This will be the big issue during the next legislature and a vote for McReynolds will be a vote against the sales tax. I am an advocate of economy in government and will oppose any measure that would place additional unfair burdens on the taxpayers."

"The last legislature passed a watered-down lobby bill and a lobbied-down water bill and I will vote to improve these important issues."
