

The committee was presented with he figures of the TEC that Borden ounty will be short 550 cotton pulrs during the peak period of the otton harvest This shortage will be met by the importation of Mexican ational Bracero workers.

.The Committee will function under Public Law 78, obtaining facts relevent to the supply of domestic farm workers existing in Borden County and the shortage of workers, if any must be met by importing Mexican Nationals to harvest the cotton crop. Under Public Law 78 the TEC must supply this information to the Secretary of Labor who must limit the number of Mexican Nationals to be used in this county by granting a "ceiling." The Comittee consults with the Local Office Manager to assist him in estimating the number of workers who will be needed, based on current local conditions affecting the cotton crop.

"Ceilings" granted by the Secretary of Labor limiting the importition of Mexican Nationals into this area will be posted in Post Offices in O'Donnell, Gail, in the County Igent's Office, and in the County




