**SHORT COURSES BENEFIT EATING ESTABLISHMENTS**

Over 15 million meals will be served in 20,000 Texas eating establishments this week. If you are average you'll eat at least two of them. You could go into the vast majority of those restaurants and cafeterias and be assured of getting a wholesome meal - totally oblivious of the fact that you are eating food cooked and served by complete strangers.

How can this be, especially since some 26 different diseases can be spread by improperly handled food? Included in the list are such scourges as trichinosis, the deadly botulism, strep infections and salmonellosis (food poisoning).

There are many reasons of course but among the main ones are the three day short courses in sanitation conducted by the State Department of Health for persons engaged in food preparation and service.

Good housekeeping around grain storage bins will pay good dividends says C. F. Garner, extension entomologist, by holding insect infestations to a minimum. He points out that lots of grain will soon be going in farm storage structures and suggests the bins be given a thorough cleaning and an application of a good residual spray before any grain is stored. Local county agents can supply details on the insecticides to use.

Moisture in seed cotton from humidity may not be seen or felt, but it is there. And it limits the kind of job the ginner can do. Excess moisture in cotton usually results in the loss of grade and quality and can cost the grower as much as 3 to 5 bales. Mechanical pickers should never be operated until the cotton moisture is down to a reasonable picking level.

Wheat growers who have experienced losses due to loose smut are advised to pick up a copy of a recent Agricultural Extension Service publication L-564 "Controlling Loose Smut of Wheat" at the local county agent's office.

**ANNUAL PHYSICAL EXAM IS BEST CANCER PREVENTION**

Cancer is often spoken of as the "silent" disease. This is because in many cases cancer grows without giving any symptom. And pain which is most often thought of as accompanying disease, is not generally present until cancer is far advanced. Most cancer can be cured when detected and treated in the early stages. The difficulty in cancer control, then, lies with the detection of the disease.

Only a physician can tell if cancer is present. Any suspicious symptom should always be examined by the family physician. But often, by the time any symptoms of cancer show up, it is too late. Treatment of advanced cancer is difficult.

The only insurance against this silent growth is a regular, at least yearly, physical examination.

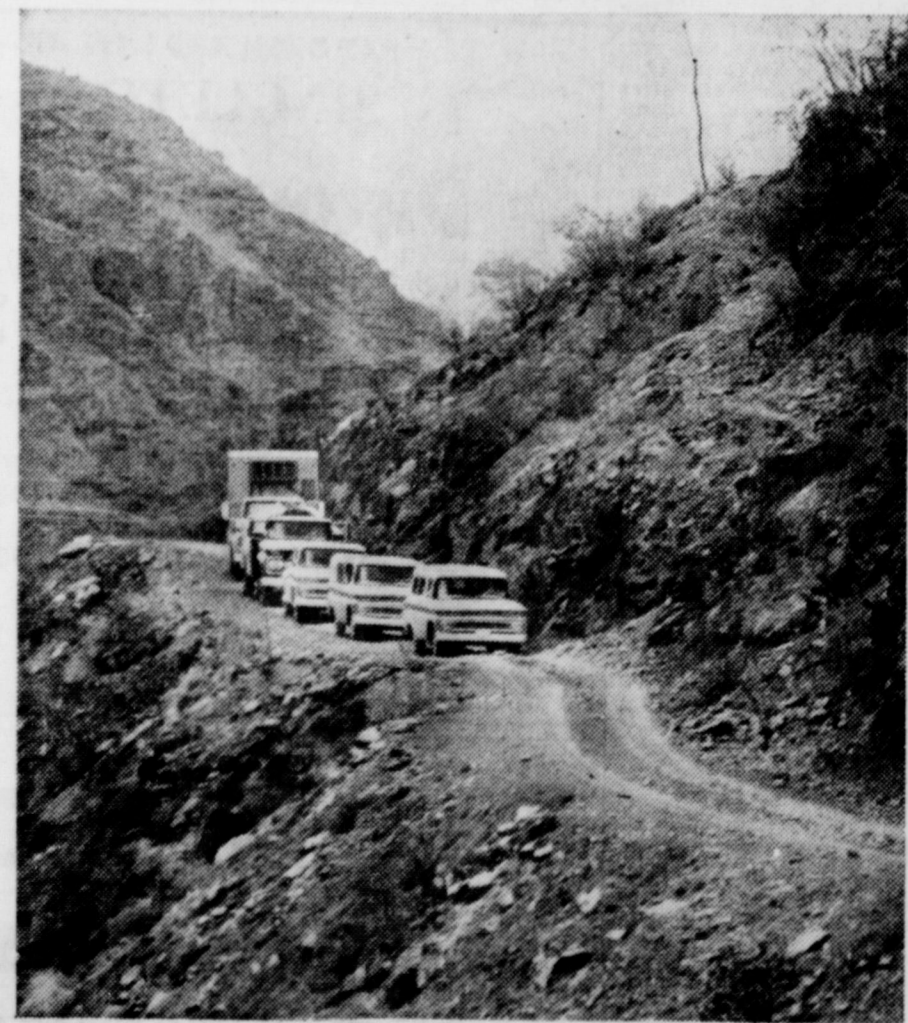

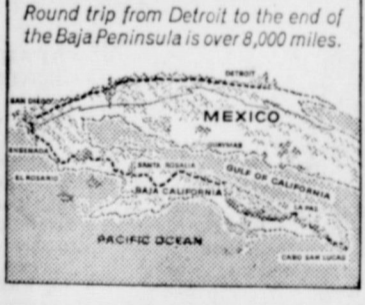

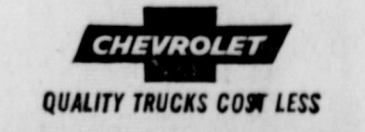


Sometimes the caravan crept along for hours in low gear. It took 17 days to go 1,066 miles! This is the road near Loreto.

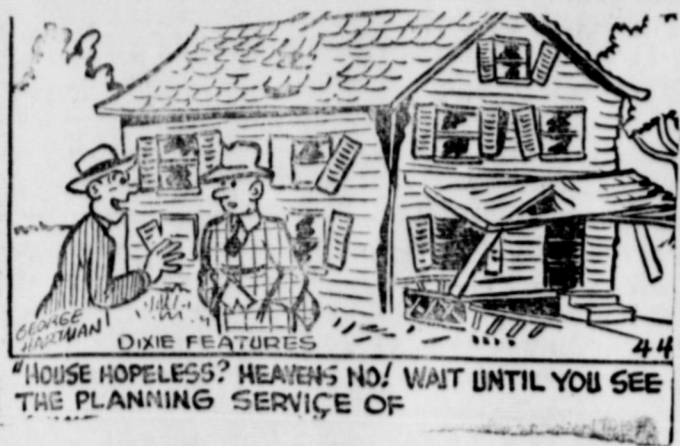

### SIGHT MAY BE LOST ---

The irreplaceable gift of sight is being lost to one American every 29 minutes.

If that figure, estimated by the National Society for the Prevention of Blindness, holds true for all population segments of the nation, it means that 1.9 million Texans are blinded every day.

September is Sight-saving Month throughout the land. Even as you read this, some man, woman, or child is standing on the brink of permanent darkness, about to join the 392,500 other Americans who are already enduring the bleak enormity of blindness.

What causes blindness? There are two major contributing factors: disease and accidents. Neglect exaggerates both of these.

Blindness brought on through neglect really is no worse than that caused by an accident or disease. But somehow it seems worse. It's so unnecessary.

If all children were given a thorough eye examination prior to entering school for the first time and if all visual defects were corrected or placed under treatment at that time, a major step in the prevention of blindness in childhood would be taken. One of every four school children are said to need some form of eye care.

But a single examination is not enough. A child grows quickly. His eyes, like every other body organ, are constantly changing. Sometime the change is for the worse.

At least half of all cases of blindness occurring from year to year could be prevented through use of the sight-saving knowledge at hand. For example, some 300,000 industrial eye injuries occur each year. The mere use of goggles would cut the figure dramatically.

As for disease-caused blindness, modern surgical methods now restore or improve vision in 19 of 20 cases of cataract, the leading cause of blindness in the United States.

When parents or teachers observe a child holding reading matter closer than the normal 14 inches from his face, tilting his head while reading, or constantly blinking, all responsible health and medical authorities agree it should be interpreted as a sign of impending eye trouble.

### Tax Hints Given --

Accurate record keeping is the best way to save federal tax money that I can think of," Campbell said. "The following pointers can be as useful to our area self-employed folks as to corporation executives claiming deductions on personal tax returns for business expenses, whether reimbursed or not." Campbell revealed that entertainment expense records should provide relation of the expenditure to the taxpayer's business, and the ordinary and necessary business purpose of the expense. Records should show the name of the person or persons entertained and the companies they represent, as well as the date and place of entertainment. "Naturally," Campbell cautioned, "the amount of the expenditure must be ordinary and necessary. If the sum is sizeable, be sure to keep a copy of the bill. It's necessary for us to know whether the entertainment was paid by out-of-pocket cash, credit card, check, or charged to the employer."
