TWIN DANGERS

Those twin menaces—heart disease—lung up a record for the number of killed last year, a final tally of death statistics shows. Of a grand total of 69,477 from all causes during 1956, half were due either to heart disease or to cancer. Heart killed 22,888 while cancer 10,168.

While the number of cases has increased perceptibly past three years, the increase has little real significance. The deaths from cancer in the United States as a whole, registered 112 deaths from for each 100,000 population the rate for the rest of the was 146 deaths per 100,000.

The disparity between the U. S. cancer death rate is due to the fact that the younger population. Cancer disease that usually strikes past 50 years of age. Of the cancer deaths last year, 50 percent were among persons past the half-century mark.

Increases in the number of deaths coming from heart disease, almost 1,800 more died from this cause during than died in 1955.

Most of the increase is in the group 55 and over. And there the irony: normal life span has been lengthened to an age heart disease has a field day.

The same reason—longer spans—is obviously behind the remarkable gain in the United States death rate from heart attack. Almost 15,000 more Americans of heart disease last year than in 1955.

As life expectancy continues to increase, more and more people are going to fall victim to heart disease. And although this fatality can be avoided, it can be delayed by a simple four-point regimen, staying it off as long as possible.

1. Reduce tensions of "living," and get moderate exercise. A nonstrenuous hobby is best.
 2. Eliminate excessive eating that taxes your heart. Do not eat.

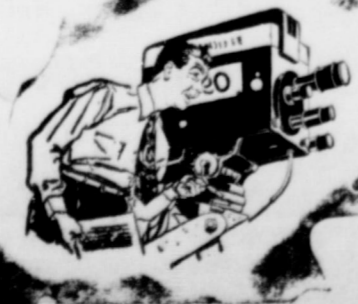

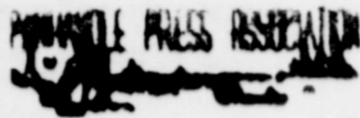

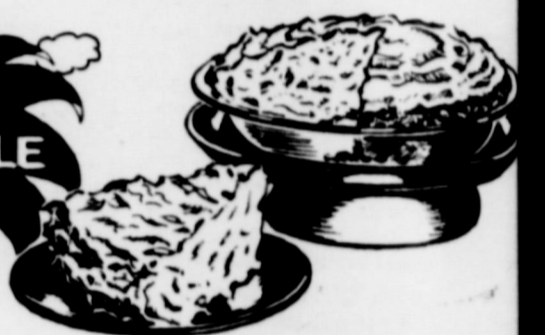

TROPICAL PINEAPPLE PIE

- 3 Tablespoons melted butter or margarine
 - 4-oz can shredded coconut (1 1/2 cups)
 - 9-oz can crushed pineapple (do not drain)
 - 1 cup water
 - 1 Tablespoon lemon juice
 - 1/2 cup sugar
 - 1/4 teaspoon salt
 - 2 eggs, separated
 - 1 pkg. instant P.F.F. (in dry form)
- Mix butter and coconut. Press in bottom and on sides of pie pan. Bake near center of 300 oven (slow) for 15 min. or until golden brown. Cool. In 1 1/2-cup pineapple, 1/2 cup of the water, lemon juice, sugar, salt and egg yolks. Cook and stir over medium heat until mixture comes to full, all-over boil. Take from heat. Stir in egg whites until dissolved. Chill until as thick as unbeaten egg whites. Put egg whites, remaining 1/2 cup of the water and INSTANT P.F.F. into 1 1/2-qt. bowl. Beat with rotary beater or electric mixer at high speed until mixture stands in peak. Beat mixture gradually until well mixed. Stir in pineapple and coconut. Chill until firm.
