Basal metabolism can be measured by a machine, and often is measured as the first step in a physical examination. There are wide variations in the normal basal metabolism, but if you don't metabolize, but you don't metabolize without those realms of normal, it does effect your health.

There are two sides to the metabolism story, of course, one being the income of outside substances and the other being the outgo. Everything that goes into your body food, air and water-- is supposed to go in for the purpose of being broken down into materials that the body can use with the waste being eliminated.

So you first need the essential materials to go into the body. Pure clean air, good water, and proper diet make up those essentials. Then the lungs and the stomach have to be in proper functioning order to send those essentials along the route of the body in which they can be separated into ingredients needed by different parts of the body.

The beginning of metabolism inside the body, then, occurs within the respiratory and digestive systems. The metabolism of the respiratory system is much easier to measure and is the one tested for the basal rate. The intake of oxygen into the body is weighed against the carbon dioxide which the body throws off as waste to determine the basal metabolism rate.

Both the respiratory system and the digestive system feed substances into the bloodstream. From the lungs the oxygen taken from the air is fed into the bloodstream. In the stomach and the small intestine food and water undergo changes which convert the materials in

the digestive system into substances that the body can use. In the intestine, these materials are squeezed out through the walls and enter the bloodstream.

So the bloodstream is the distributor of the essential ingredients to all parts of the body.

In the bloodstream and in the organs of the body are regulators, chemicals which seem to know the of each organ of the body. These regulators are called hormones. When something that one particular organ needs comes along in the bloodstream, like a laden ship, the hormone acts like a tugboat, pulling that ship into the organ out of the harbor of the organism. There it goes by unloading the ship's cargo, puts new freight aboard, and sends the ship in to another part of the body.

The hormones are very important in the metabolism of the body. Everything that every organ needs is supposed to be in the bloodstream if proper health measures are followed, but if the hormones are not abundant enough or strong enough to pull the ingredients into the organ from the bloodstream, that organ cannot perform its part in the overall picture of the body metabolism.

Getting all the ingredients that each organ needs to the spot in the body where it can be picked up is the first phrase of metabolism. Taking away the waste material from every part of the body is the second part and is every bit as important as the first.

Clothes moths feed on animal substances such as wool, hair, feathers, fur and a wide range of commodities made from these materials. They can be controlled by using a five per cent DDT dust or spray. Winter clothing should be dry cleaned and sealed in airtight bags for summer storage and protection against damage from clothes moths.

Metabolism is that process by which the body takes in outside materials, uses the parts it needs and expels the waste. The simplest phase of metabolism, called basal metabolism, is the use of air in the relaxed state.
